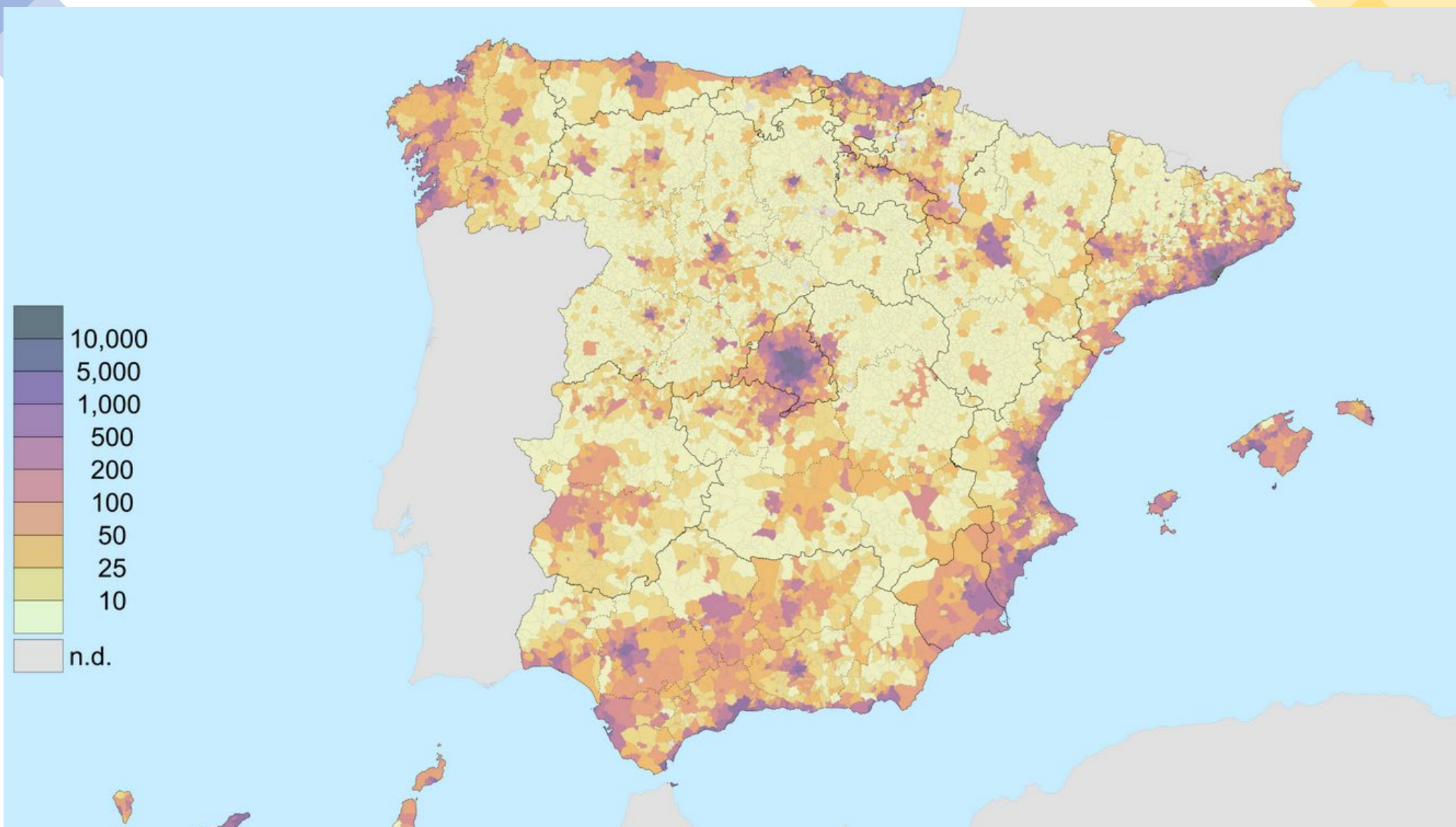

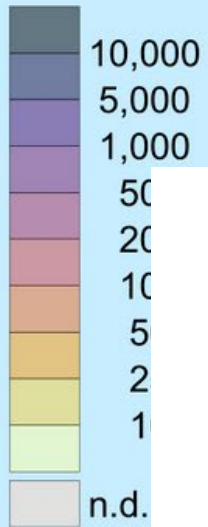

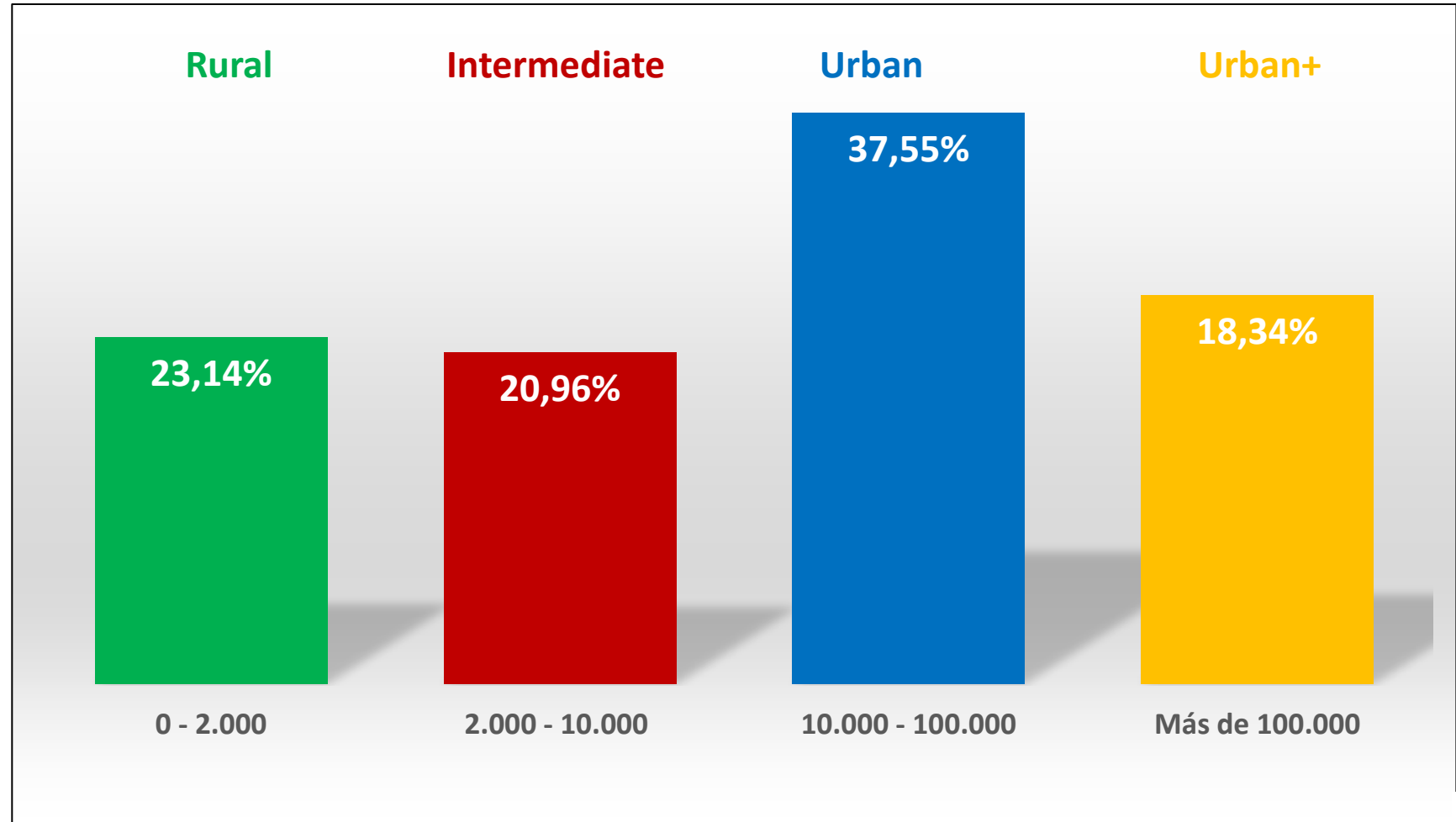

## Weaving the network

Citizens-Admin.

Inside the city,  
between citizens

Show and share experiences and provide space to learn from each other, resolve doubts, and facilitate debate

Facilitate contact and generate mutual support “sub-networks” between municipalities, which facilitates sharing resources (materials, tools, reports...) and learning

Improve the quality of the projects and actions: annual meetings, guides and tools, meta-synthesis of diagnoses (>100) and plans (>60)

The Core Team is made up of older people from Bilbao who decides to become actively involved in the programme, "make it theirs" and commit to promoting it, in direct and close collaboration with the city council.
