Deforestation
New EU rules to reduce deforestation related to production and import into the EU of cattle, cocoa, coffee, palm oil and soya

Summary
The EU has increased the maximum residue level (MRL) for pyridaben on grapefruit to 0.3 mg/kg, following the request for an import tolerance based on use of pyridaben in the USA.

Recommended Actions
Authorizations of feed additives are granted for a limited time period, and a transitional period applies.
Main EU countries producing feed additives, compound feed and feed materials should check the [EU Register of Feed Additives](#) regularly to ensure that they respect the conditions of use and the timelines.

Every trader or inspector should study in detail the specific standards of the products that he or she will have to deal with based on the official text (UNECE) and thanks to the interpretative brochures (OECD and UNECE). The interpretative brochures will guide you for each of the products with appropriate photos on limits allowed and show examples of what is not allowed for that specific product.

Many aspects of the marketing standards will come back in detail in the following modules when discussing the different aspects of the inspection of conformity to the stand
