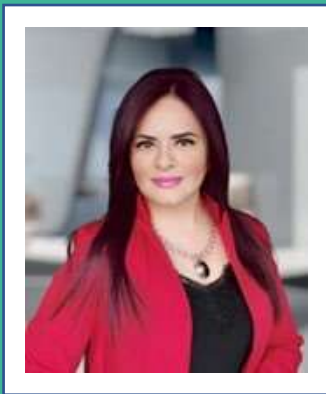
CANDIDATE BIOGRAPHY
