





FORMALITIES TO ENTER ON THE FRENCH TERRITORY

Each member of your delegation must be in possession of a valid outbound ticket (air, rail) and a a visa when one is necessary. Participants from the EU do not need a visa for France. Those from Canada and the US do not need a visa for visits of less than 90 days on French territory. Holders of a diplomatic passport are invited to contact the French Consular or other diplomatic representation in their country to obtain the relevant information regarding their entrance on French territory.

The rules of obtaining a visa can be subject to change. All participants are invited to contact the French consular authorities at their place of residence before their departure to ensure they hold all the necessary documents.
