The objective of the workshop is to encourage transport, health and environment policymakers to work together in developing strategies and measures for sustainable and healthy urban transport, with a focus on Eastern Europe and Caucasus. Participants will identify needs, challenges and opportunities to promote innovative policies and mobility management programmes that support environmentally friendly and healthy transport policies and improve urban livelihoods in Kyiv and cities of the region.

The overarching theme of the workshop is integrated policy approaches to sustainable urban transport. In accordance with Goal 2 of the Amsterdam Declaration, the specific focus is on mobility management, public transport and transport information technology, including technical expertise on signs and signals for pedestrians and cyclists.

The Kyiv workshop is the next in a series of events under THE PEP relay race (staffette), launched in January 2009 in Amsterdam and followed by workshops in Pruhonice, Czech Republic (September 2009), Skopje (June 2010) and Batumi, Georgia (September 2010).
