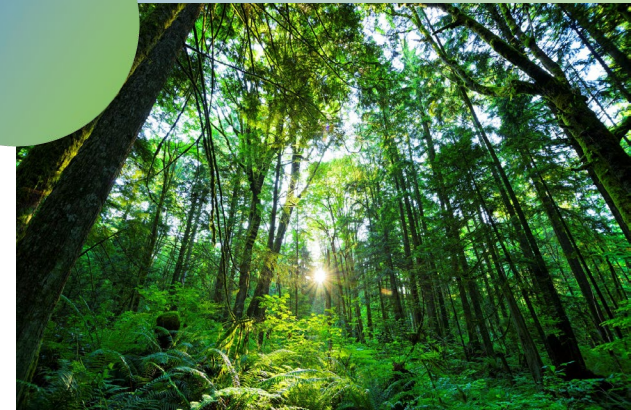

# Forestry chapters in latest EPRs

- Armenia,
- Azerbaijan,
- Kyrgyz Republic – 2022
  - Forest area has increased
  - Pressures from illegal logging, livestock grazing, fires, pests, diseases
  - Timber harvesting prohibited, supply of imported wood from Russia
  - Forest plays important role for local communities
  - Community-based forest management process has stalled
