Dear Ms Marshall,

I wish to inform you that Ireland is content not to make an oral statement regarding the admissibility of PRE/ACCC/C/2023/199 at the open session of the 79th meeting of the Compliance Committee on 13th June.

However, we will be in attendance remotely at the open sessions on both the 13th and on the 16th to answer any questions that the Committee might have in relation to this matter.

Without prejudice to the rights of Ireland to respond in due course to both the communication and, insofar as necessary, the Communicant's statement on preliminary admissibility, all of which rights are reserved, we wish also to inform you that we will not be challenging the admissibility of the Communication.

We will respond, in due course, under the Committee's procedures, to all of the issues raised in the Communication and the Communicant's statement of admissibility.

It is denied that Ireland is not in compliance with Articles 1, 3(1), 4(8) and 9(4) of the Convention.
