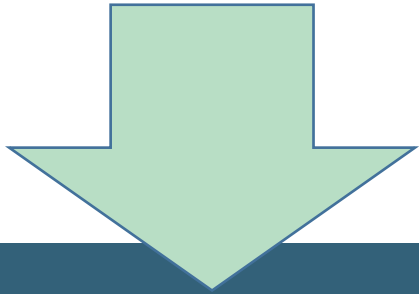


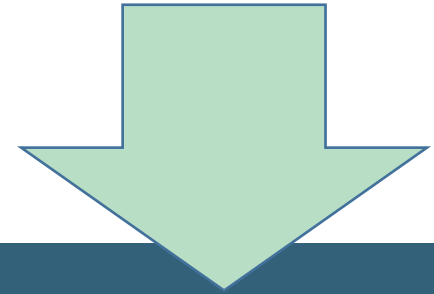

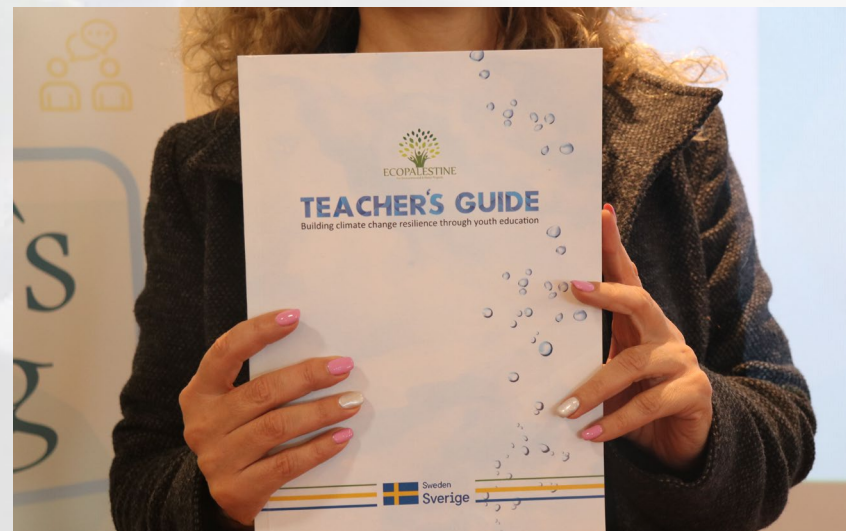

RIVER RUNS THROUGH IT

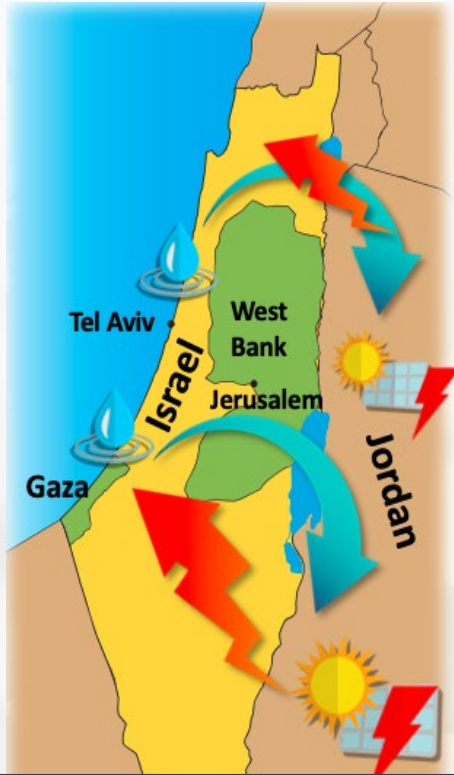
