



Stakeholder consultation workshop on the draft UNECE Country Profile on Urban Development, Housing and Land Management of Albania 26 June 2023, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. CET

Concept Note

Background:

The Country Profiles on urban development, housing and land management series is a flagship product of the UNECE Committee on Urban Development, Housing and Land Management (https://unece.org/housing/country-profiles). The Country Profiles is a valuable tool to analyse countries' urban development, housing and land management policies, strategies, and institutional and financial frameworks and to compare the progress made internationally. Based on the analysis, Country Profiles provide action-oriented recommendations to the government to support their efforts in addressing the identified immediate and long-term capacity needs at the planning and implementation levels, including legislative and policy reforms and capacity-building needs. Therefore, Country Profiles are evidence-based studies which also help governments to establish an integrated approach to housing, urban development and land management following the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development principle of policy coherence.

The Country Profile on Urban Development, Housing and Land Management for Albania is being developed in 2022-2023 upon the request of the Government of Albania¹ - please see more information on the draft in the Power Point presentation on the project. The secretariat of the UNECE Committee on Urban Development, Housing and Land Management started work in 2022 and engaged with international experts as well as national experts in Albania. The UNECE Regional Programme for Technical Cooperation (RPTC) and the UN Resident Coordinator Office in Albania are providing support to the development of the Country Profile of Albania. The Polis University, the UNECE Centre of Excellence on Sustainable and Resilient Settlements, is the local coordinator for the development of the Profile. The Country Profile for Albania draws on experiences gained from the previous Country Profile of Albania (the first one was published in 2002 - https://unece.org/info/Housing-and-Land-Management/pub/2894) as well as Country Profiles developed for other countries.

The draft Country Profile publication will be shared with the workshop participants two weeks in advance of this stakeholder workshop. The participants are invited to read the draft and prepare their questions and comments; and proposals for factual corrections for the chapters in the draft. They will have a possibility to present their comments and proposals for the corrections during the meeting or otherwise they can send written comments to Ms. Sadmira Malaj at sadmira malaj@universitetipolis.edu.al.
