

Public Participation in international forums under Aarhus Convention, EU and national law on water management

- Article 3(7) of the Aarhus Convention requires that "Each Party shall promote the application of the principles of this Convention in international environmental decision-making processes and within the framework of international organizations in matters relating to the environment."
- EU Water Framework Directive (WFD), places public participation at the center stage of water management as part of its integrated approach to water management.
- Article 14 Public information and consultation "Member States shall encourage the active involvement of all interested parties in the implementation of this Directive, in particular in the production, review and updating of the river basin management plans."
- WFD calls for public participation in order to ensure protection and a sustainable use of the European river basins
- Croatian legislation includes all this requirements ...








Sava River Basin and contracting parties of FASRB

Framework Agreement on the Sava River Basin, FASRB (signed 2002, on force 2004)



Parties to the FASRB: Croatia, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Serbia, Slovenia

Specific goals:

- To establish an international regime of navigation
- To establish sustainable water management
- To prevent/limit hazards (floods, droughts, ice and accidents) and reduce/eliminate their negative consequences






"Let's work with nature" Competition

"Keep the Danube Blue," inspired by the 4th Joint Danube Survey (JDS4), one of the world's most comprehensive surface water monitoring efforts








