At the closing session of the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee's seventy-ninth meeting (Geneva, 13-16 June 2023), the Chair announced the outcome of the Committee's deliberations on the preliminary admissibility of communications at that meeting.

In case you were not able to be present for that session, I write to inform you that the Committee has determined that communication ACCC/C/2022/195 (Spain) is admissible on a preliminary basis with respect to the issue set out in paragraph 9, on page 4, of the communicant's letter of 30 May 2023 only. The Committee has determined all other allegations in the communication to be inadmissible under paragraph 20 (d) of the annex to decision I/7 for being incompatible with the provisions of the Convention.

As the next step, the Party concerned will be invited to provide its written response to the issue set out in paragraph 9 of the communicant's letter of 30 May 2023, in accordance with paragraph 23 of the annex to decision I/7.
