### **EU Clean Air Forum - Introduction**

- A major biennial clean air policy event supporting implementation of EU clean air legislation and policies.
- High-level interventions, panel discussions, and expert exchanges.
- Aiming to engage stakeholders in dialogue and information-sharing, to inform about and promote good practices and to inspire ambitious commitments to air pollution reduction measures.
- An EU-wide measure, it also includes speakers and participants from outside the EU.





#### **Event format**

- The EU Clean Air Forum comprises a high-level segment and topic-specific sessions for more in-depth discussions.
- Information materials produced for the Forum meetings (e.g. brochures, videos, reports) to provide added value in the longer time frame.
- Organised and designed in close cooperation with the hosting city/Member State
- EU Member States volunteer for co-hosting the Forum.

- The European Commission is organising the fourth EU Clean Air Forum in close collaboration with the Ministry for Infrastructure & Water Management of the Netherlands.

## Arctic Black Carbon impacting Climate and Air Pollution (ABC-iCAP

- The EU-funded project Arctic Black Carbon impacting Climate and Air Pollution (ABC-iCAP) promoting awareness building and knowledge sharing with stakeholders that include the Air Convention and its subsidiary bodies, to reduce emissions of black carbon and methane impacting the Arctic.
- Work under the ABC-iCAP project includes sharing guidance documents and developing capacity-building, with a focus on Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia (EECCA) countries, to meet air quality objectives and support eventual ratification of the amended Gothenburg Protocol.
