Daniela García is a career Foreign Service Diplomat currently working as Deputy Permanent Representative at the Mission of Ecuador to the WTO, UNCTAD, WIPO and ITC.

Daniela coordinates for Ecuador the Dialogue on Plastic Pollution at the WTO, together with Australia, Barbados, China, Fiji and Morocco. Also, she facilitates negotiations for cybersecurity at the ECOM JSI; and is part of the team that supports a global response to environmental challenges at Foreign Affairs.

In the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Miss García served as chief of staff at the Undersecretariat for Multilateral Affairs which oversees environmental, human rights and security negotiations; she was also the negotiator for cybersecurity issues, and for trade and gender in the negotiations with Mexico and Chile.

She has also been appointed as focal point human rights related issues, in particular with regards to gender, privacy and data protection; and as representative from Foreign Affairs to develop the national policy for Cybersecurity.

Daniela holds a degree in International Relations and Trade from the University of Azuay in Ecuador and a Master of Public Policy at the Australian National University, where she was also awarded a scholarship for her National Security studies. She speaks fluent Spanish, French and English.
