Election of UN/CEFACT Bureau Vice Chairs

Note by the UN/CEFACT Chair

Summary

The twenty-sixth Plenary should elect at least four UN/CEFACT Bureau Vice Chairs. Eight nominations have been received. The UN/CEFACT Chair proposes that the Plenary elect all eight candidates by acclamation.

Document ECE/TRADE/C/CEFACT/2020/INF.10 is submitted by the UN/CEFACT Chair to the twenty-sixth session of the Plenary for decision.

- 1. The elections for Vice Chair of the UN/CEFACT Bureau was circulated to Missions and Heads of Delegation on 29 January 2020. UN/CEFACT procedures requires a minimum of four Vice Chairs.
- 2. Eight candidature nominations were received within the prescribed deadline and were circulated to Missions and Heads of Delegation on 18 March 2020:
 - Australia nominates Mr. Ian Watt
 - · Canada nominates Mr. Marek Laskowski
 - · France nominates Ms. Hanane Becha
 - India nominates Mr. Tahseen Khan
 - · Italy nominates Ms. Liliana Fratini Passi
 - The Netherlands nominates Mr. Benno Slot
 - Nigeria nominates Ms. Estelle Igwe
 - The Russian Federation nominates Mr. Aleksei Bondarenko
- 3. Activity within UN/CEFACT is continually growing as reflected by the number of documents presented to this Plenary as well as the 1280 experts registered to volunteer within UN/CEFACT. The Chair of UN/CEFACT believes that a Bureau composed of eight Vice Chairs would help to share and distribute this increase in activity.
- 4. There have been several member States who have suggested that all eight candidates be elected by acclamation.
- 5. The Chair of UN/CEFACT proposes that the Plenary considers positively the election of all eight candidates by acclamation.
