

## **Transit Schengen Visa for Italy**

Even though your final destination is the Republic of San Marino, transit visa for Italy are mandatory for participants requiring a visa for the Schengen area.

## Please follow this process:

- Before applying for a visa please register at https://unece.org/info/Forests/events/374850
- 2. Registered participants requiring a Schengen visa, please contact <u>liliana.annovazzi-jakab@un.org</u> to obtain the UNECE issued visa facilitation letter as soon as possible.
- 3. Please make sure you have:
  - Completed the visa application form: you must fill in the online form at <a href="https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home/en">https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home/en</a> specifying "Transit" as the reason for your stay.
  - The documents proving the need to transit through the Schengen area, i.e., the following letters which the UNECE secretariat provides:
    - Invitation letter from the Executive Secretary Olga Algayerova
    - Invitation letter from Minister Canti
    - Visa Facilitation letter issued by UNECE Secretariat
  - A recent passport-size photo;
  - A valid travel document expiry date should not be later than 3 months after the expected return date;
  - A return ticket;
  - A valid health insurance

Please apply as soon as possible via the nearest Italian diplomatic representation in your country of residence. They will help you with inquiries about visa applications.

Participants are fully responsible for all their travel-and insurance related expenses (including flights, transfers, accommodation, and insurance) and for obtaining the visa.
