- More changes implemented after the discussions at the meeting, Organized in three themes (Monitoring, Modelling, Impacts) with Monitoring and Modelling subdivided into Water, Air, Soil, Biota and Materials
- published the latest version beginning of September, available now at www.unece-wge.org
