


2-3. Activity diagram








2-4-2. Class diagram-Information requester






2-4-3. Class diagram-Information provider






2-4-4. Class diagram-Price

- Any business entity, or even a private person could develop EPs.
- New IT technologies (Blockchain, XR, API, etc.) are emerging and applicable.

Challenges for EP SMEs

- Poor capital
- Lack of IT capability
- Weak management
- Poor service level of transportation
- Fewer quality accommodations

Environmental and social factors

- Re-vitalization of local areas
- Fondness of people for visiting local areas
- Consciousness of sustainable environments by visitors

6. Support to apply EPs TA among business communities



- 1) EPs TA is ready for use by any one or organization.
- 2) T/T Domain experts will encourage its use in the T/T domain community together with the relevant IT developers.

7. Development to the next step of the project

- 1) The Project Proposal named as 'API Transformation of EPs Technical Artefacts with Sustainability Claims' was recently approved by Bureau.
- 2) This is the next step of the project, 'Experience Programs Technical Artefacts Project'.
- 3) This will be completed in a year starting now.
- 4) The main purpose is to make the use of EPs TA easier.
- 5) One of the major scopes is the transformation of EPs TA into API formats based on the UN/CEFACT API Specifications.
 - The other one is to develop the BIEs of Sustainability Claims by using the output of 'Business Standards for Sustainable Tourism Project'
