Project title: Supporting UNECE member States in the development and implementation of the United Nations Framework Classification for Resources (UNFC) and the United Nations Resource Management System (UNRMS) – Phase II

Expected timing/ duration: January 2024 – December 2027

Objective and brief summary of the project: The objective of the project is to build capacities in UNECE member States for sustainable management of resources through the application of UNFC and UNRMS. This project is a continuation of project E357 "Supporting UNECE member States in the development and implementation of the United Nations Framework Classification for Resources and the United Nations Resource Management System - Phase Î' (2020-2024). Attainment of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) requires energy and raw materials, but there is a need to make resource production and use more efficient and carbon neutral. Due to the exponential growth in the quantities of resources consumed by society, progress towards a carbon-neutral society, including a shift toward a circular economy paradigm, has become necessary. Such energy transition needs secure supply chains for critical raw materials, required as well for diverse social and economic sectors, including health and agriculture. UNFC and UNRMS provide a unified, comparable, interoperable and harmonized approach to resource assessment and management adapt for governmental, statistical, corporate and financial purposes. The Expert Group on Resource Management (EGRM) is mandated to develop and support the implementation of UNFC, an internationally applicable classification scheme for energy and mineral resources. In its recent work, EGRM has developed UNFC for resources including solar, geothermal, wind and bioenergy, as well as anthropogenic resources, and work is underway on hydro and marine energy, groundwater and hydrogen. EGRM is also mandated to develop UNRMS as a dynamic system for sustainable resource management based on information structured through UNFC. The United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) has endorsed UNFC and UNRMS (Decision 2004/233 and Resolution E/RES/2023/19 respectively) for global application. UNFC and UNRMS represent an integrated toolkit to assist countries in managing their natural resources sustainably and in alignment with the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. UNFC- and UNRMS-based classification and management provide the basis for reliable and coherent information on the natural resource base, which can be used for policymaking and directing capital investments. The objective of the project will be achieved by implementing the following activities:

Supporting further development and maintenance of UNFC

- A1.1. Further develop and maintain UNFC specifications for a unified, comparable, interoperable and harmonized system for resource assessment;
- A1.2. Develop and maintain UNFC application guidelines for classification of multiple resources;
- A1.3. Develop and maintain UNFC best practices for resource classification;
- A1.4. Develop UNFC case studies at country and corporate levels;

Supporting the development and maintenance of UNRMS

- A2.1. Develop and maintain the fundamental principles of sustainable resource management;
- A2.2. Develop and maintain the concepts and terminology for sustainable resource management;
- A2.3. Develop and maintain the structure and specifications of UNRMS;
- A2.4. Develop and maintain data, information and knowledge standards and guidelines for UNRMS;

Supporting the implementation of UNFC for sustainable resource management, including UNRMS

- A3.1. Facilitate UNFC deployment activities across the UNECE region for administrative, statistical, corporate and financial purposes;
- A3.2. Coordinate, monitor, review, assess and evaluate UNFC implementation efforts across the UNECE region;
- A3.3. Facilitate the creation of networks of UNFC experts through webinars, virtual and in-person workshops and training courses, conduct awareness raising and capacity-building workshops on UNFC/UNRMS in the UNECE region for local administrations and expert communities and facilitate the participation of experts in EGRM-related activities and events;
- A3.4 Develop and disseminate training materials, UNFC- and UNRMS-based toolkits to support the establishment of capacity and knowledge foundations for different stakeholders (governments, experts, financial sector, industry);

Fostering the application of UNFC and UNRMS to support energy resilient systems and the energy transition

- A4.1. Facilitate the application of UNFC in relation to critical raw materials value chains in the UNECE region and beyond. Development of training materials to support the establishment of capacity and knowledge foundations for UNFC and UNRMS;
- A4.2. Develop and disseminate UNFC- and UNRMS-based toolkits for sustainable management of resources to support the energy transition;
- A4.3. Support the coordination by EGRM of International Centres of Excellence on Sustainable Resource Management (ICE-SRM), aimed at facilitating the dissemination of policy tools and reporting codes to relevant national and regional stakeholders;
- A4.4. Communication to relevant stakeholders through different dissemination channels (website, social media, workshops, training courses) in the UNECE region and beyond.

Expected results of the project:

EA1. Improved globally harmonized classification of natural resources using UNFC to aid sustainable development;

EA3. Strengthened mechanisms for harmonized and uniform UNFC and UNRMS implementation at national and regional levels, including by the financial sector and industry, in UNECE member States;

EA4. Improved understanding by UNECE member States and other countries of the application of UNFC and UNRMS to support resilient energy systems and the energy transition.

Target group and beneficiaries of the project: All UNECE member States are beneficiaries of the project. The target audience is senior officials from ministries of natural resources, geological surveys, experts and senior professionals from the mining, energy and water sectors, industry and financial institutions.

Justification of project and its relationship to the programme of work: The project is directly linked to the objectives of Subprogramme 5 "Sustainable Energy" "to ensure access to affordable and clean energy for all and reduce greenhouse gas emissions and the carbon footprint of the energy sector in the region" of the UNECE programme budget for 2023.
