**Re: Decision VII/8q concerning compliance by Turkmenistan  
with its obligations under the Aarhus Convention**

The Compliance Committee under the Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention) has asked me to write to you as a courtesy to remind you that, in accordance with paragraph 4 (a) of decision VII/8q of the Meeting of the Parties, Turkmenistan is requested to submit to the Committee its first progress report by **1 October 2023** on the measures it has by that date taken, and the results achieved, to implement the recommendations in paragraphs 2 (a)-(b) of decision VII/8q.

The Committee has also asked me to remind you that, in paragraph 5 of decision VII/8q, the Meeting of the Parties decided to issue a caution to the Party concerned, to become effective on 1 January 2024, unless the Party concerned has fully satisfied the conditions set out in paragraph 2 (a) and (b) above and has notified the secretariat of this fact by **1 October 2023**.

In addition, as explained by the Chair of the Committee at the twenty-seventh meeting (Geneva, 26-28 June 2023), all the measures to implement decision VII/8q must be taken and reported on by no later than 1 October 2024 in order that they can be taken into consideration by the Committee in its report on decision VII/8q to the eighth session of the Meeting of the Parties.

As you may recall, at its twenty-seventh meeting, the Working Group of the Parties to the Convention took note of the information provided by the Chair of the Compliance Committee and “urged all Parties subject to a decision of the Meeting of the Parties concerning its compliance to implement that decision in a timely and effective manner, especially where the implementation requires legislative measures”.<sup>1</sup>

Finally, should Turkmenistan demonstrate to the Committee that it has fully met the requirements of decision VII/8q by the time of its final progress report due on 1 October 2024, the Committee will report that fact to the eighth session of the Meeting of the Parties. There would then be no need for a further decision on those points to be adopted at the eighth session.
