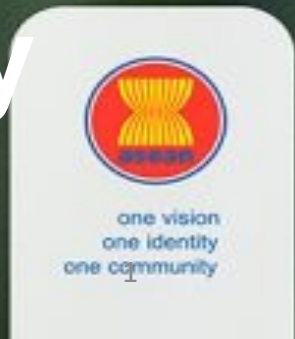

Provides a structured pathway to adopt the circular economic model

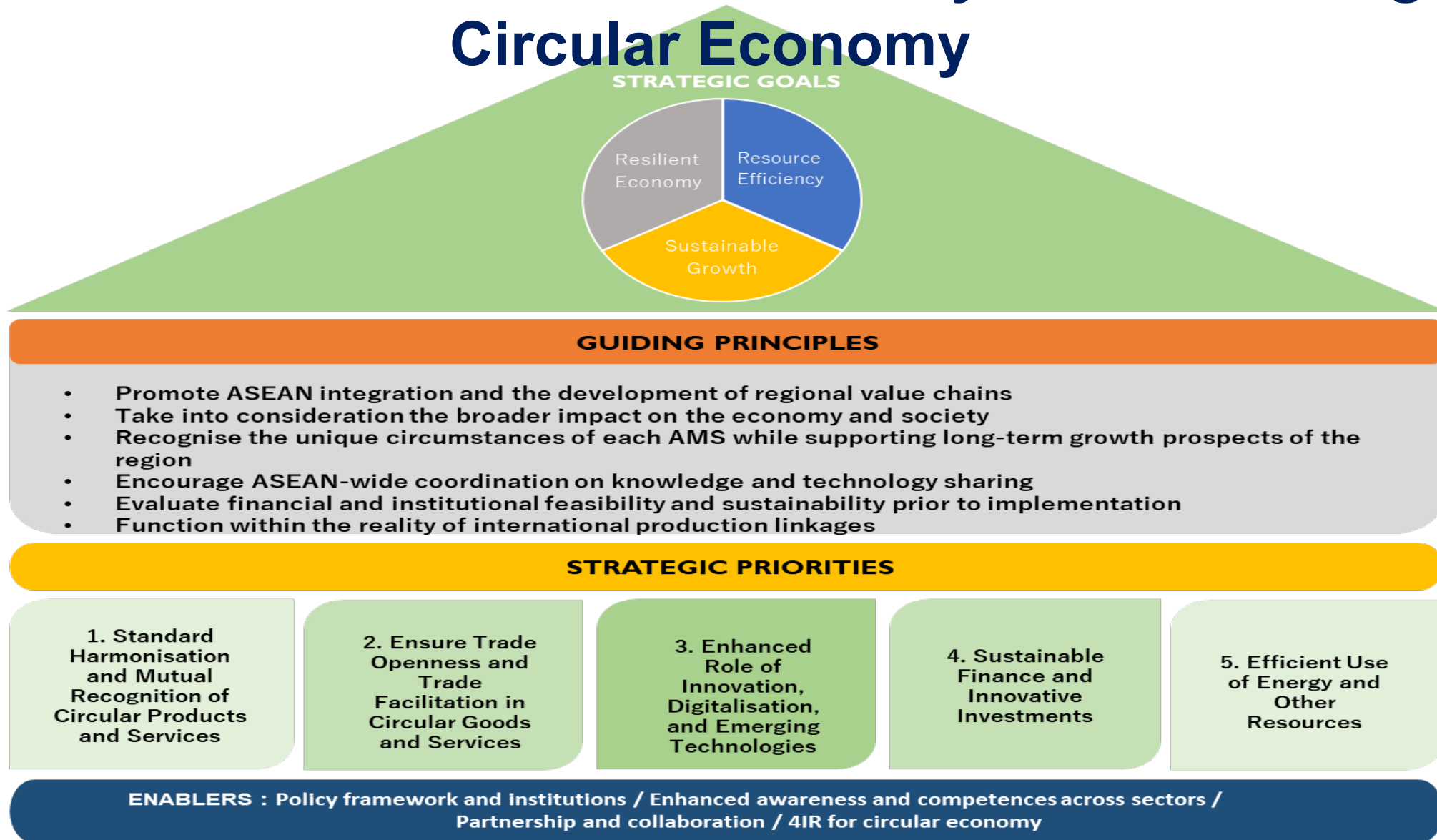

Focus is on Capacity Building



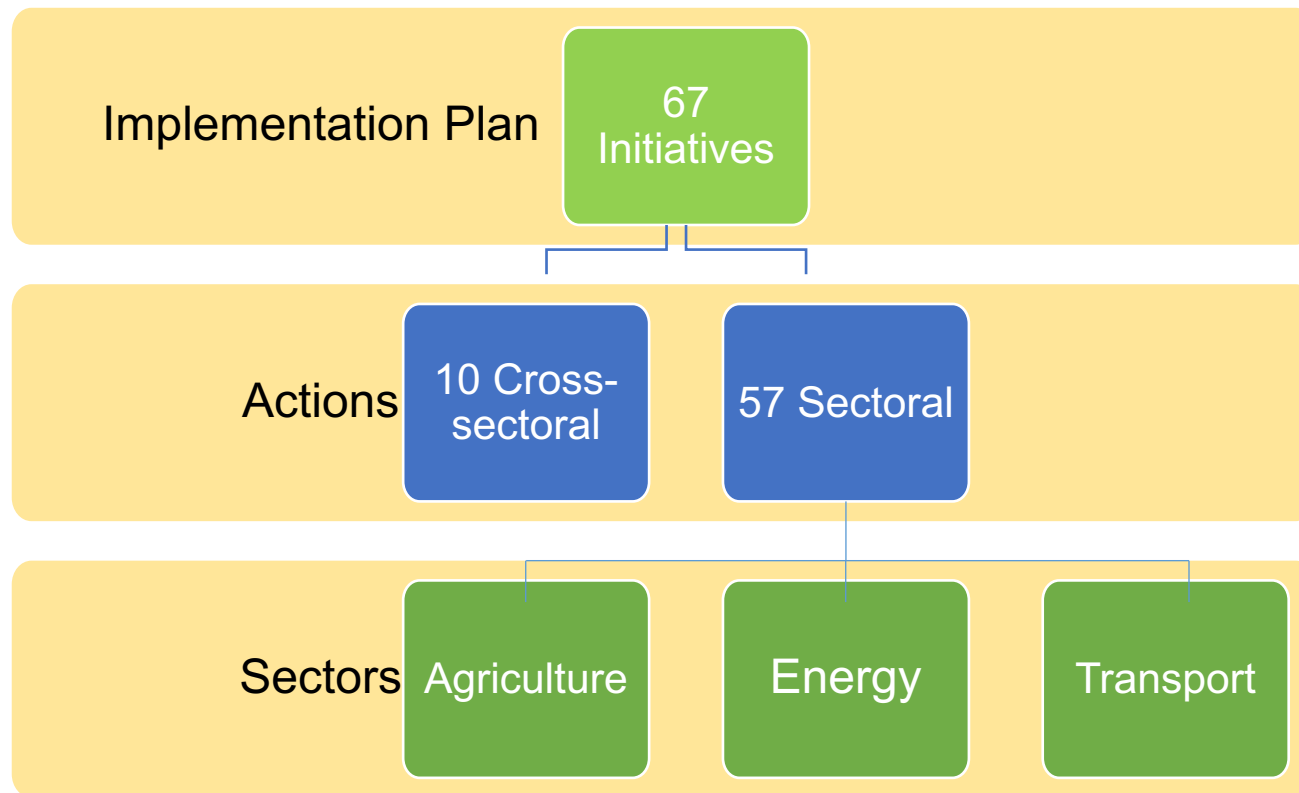
Applicable to all sectors, covering 5 components



Implementation period of 5 years



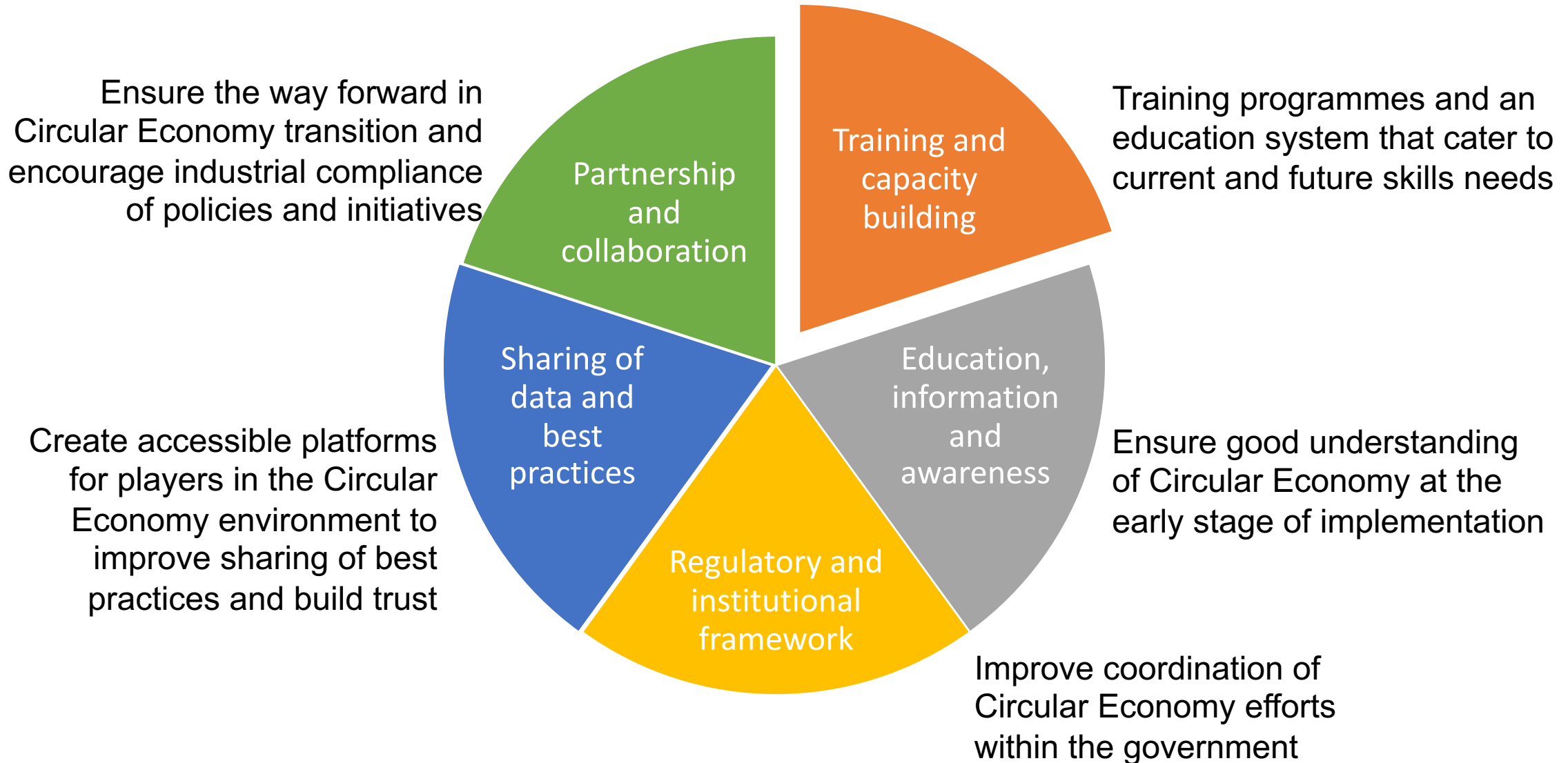
Implementation Plan for the Framework [2023-2030]



Activities fall into four major categories:

- i) **Standards** related to production processes and characteristic of CE products
- ii) **Trade facilitation** to improve or expedite the movement of products or items that meet the CE standards
- iii) **Access to sustainable finance** from both the private and public sector perspectives
- iv) **Capacity building** to enhance knowledge, deepen understanding and strengthen capacity of the private sector, regulators, policymakers to implement the transition to CE
