Project Purpose:

The same applies to accommodation services (Lodgings) etc. The aim of the project is to clearly define sustainable tourism, as well as to set parameters for what can and what should not be considered sustainable tourism.

PROJECT PURPOSE:


Experience Programs Technical Artefacts Project (P1082) was completed in October in 2022, and some members in the tourism industry expect to have the artefacts transformed into API formats based on the newly constructed technical specifications of UN/CEFACT to trade Experience Programs (EPs) much lighter and easier for the use of smart phones. Therefore, this project is proposed to make API applicable to the use of the trade of EPs, which will support the facilitation of their trade and at the same time when to trade EPs, their sustainability information based on SDGs and self-assessed by relevant suppliers could be transferred to the buyers to let them understand the level of the sustainability goal of the EPs they are going to buy. The necessary BIEs for sustainability information could be extracted from the output of Business Standards for Sustainable Tourism Project (P1078) or its succeeding one. This information could be checked by the buyers and might be commented after they have experienced. This feedback information of the buyers might contribute the enhancement of sustainability to the industry.

Project Purpose:

The project enables replacing the current emails and spreadsheets used to exchange tour package data between Travel Agencies (mostly SME's) and Destination Managing Company (DMC) and Destination Managing Organization (DMO) with harmonized data and comments. (Ref red arrows in the diagram below). This will deliver additional semantic data definition into the CCL, RDM establishing the ability to write standardized APIs.

Project status: Launch: 2023-May-08; Completion 2024-Sep-30; Publication (Plenary) 2024-Nov-30

Next Steps:

The project deliverables are:

- 1. A Reference Data Models (RDM) of and APIs specifications to cover the travel agency, Destination Managing Company (DMC) and Destination Managing Organization (DMO).
- 2. The other related Reference Data Models (RDM) and API specifications developed and information involved.

Finance & Payment Domain

CURRENT PROJECTS:

Check-IBAN Open finance use case (approved by the Bureau on July 2023)

Scope:

The purpose of this project is to develop an information exchange standard for the Check IBAN open finance use case, to enhance cybersecurity and fraud detection measures within electronic business and international trade by immediately verifying the correct association between a given IBAN code and a certain Tax Code/VAT number.

Deliverables:

- Business Requirement Specification
- Optional: NDR (Naming and Design Rules); RSM (Requirements Specification Mapping)

Forum outcomes and next steps:

- The project ha been officially launched in Bangkok after having gained the support of n. 3 HoD
- A first summary of the BRS has been presented and discussed during the domain meeting
- Based on this summary and on the feedback received from the experts, the domain is going to develop a first draft of the BRS
- A call for participation is in progress for this project



Accounting & Audit Domain

CURRENT PROJECTS:

Accounting & Audit Reference Data Model pilot project

About this project:

- The project will develop a high-level semantic Reference Data Model in the area of Accounting and Audit under the UN/CEFACT principle of semantic hub of its Prospective Directions document of 2016.
- A proof of concept (POC) is in progress to validate a VAT/sales tax use case
- The POC demonstrates that VAT/sales tax data can be expressed in two standards (XBRL-GL and SAF-T)

Forum outcomes and next steps

- No activities took place this week due to domain team availability
- GEFEG training and import of existing mappings is in progress
- Agreement to develop the Accounting & Audit RDM as part of the BSP RDM
- Import the XBRL-GL standard into GEFEG
- Migrate mappings and develop the Accounting
