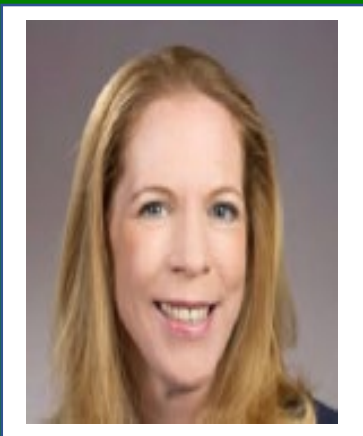

Ms. Tuerk is Director of the Economic Cooperation and Trade Division (ECTD) at UNECE and leads the Division's work across its four Sections: Cooperation and Partnerships, Innovative Policies Development, Market Access and Trade Facilitation.

The Division works to support closer economic relations among UNECE's 56 member States in the pursuit of the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the 2030 Agenda.

Prior to that, Ms. Tuerk acted as Chief of the Section on International Investment Agreements (IIAs) in UNCTAD's Division on Investment and Enterprise (DIAE), where she led the Section's work across the three pillars of UNCTAD activities: research and analysis, capacity-building and consensus-building.

Ms. Tuerk's earlier professional activities included functions in UNCTAD's Division on International Trade and Commodities (DITC), covering e.g. WTO accessions and GATS negotiations, in the Geneva office of the Center for International Environmental Law (CIEL) and in the World Trade Organization (WTO).
