Background

The SPECA Working Group on Innovation and Technology for Sustainable Development (WG on ITSD) is a subsidiary body under the UN Special Programme for the Economies of Central Asia (SPECA), comprising senior policymakers, researchers, decision-makers and other stakeholders in the area of innovation and technology from the seven participating SPECA countries, namely Afghanistan, Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan.

The SPECA WG on ITSD provides a platform to discuss and forge cooperation around, especially from the perspective of policy and the role of governance, solutions that innovation and technology have to offer to benefit from the opportunities of knowledge-based development. Especially relevant are SDGs directly related to the development of innovation and technology (in particular, SDGs 8, 9, 13 and 17).

The SPECA WG on ITSD looks, inter alia, at:

- ICT for development;
- Promotion of innovation and innovative technology applications;
- Promotion of transfer and commercialization of innovative technologies; and
- Development of effective infrastructure for innovation support and financing, including through public-private partnerships (PPPs)¹.

<u>Objectives</u>

This session of the SPECA WG on ITSD serves to assess progress in the implementation of the <u>Action</u> <u>Plan</u> of the <u>SPECA Innovation Strategy for Sustainable Development</u> as approved by the 16th session of the SPECA Governing Council in Tashkent on 19 November 2021.

A questionnaire will be presented to SPECA focal points and nominated participants prior to the session, and implementation progress will be discussed at the preceding subregional workshop.

The Action Plan guides policies and initiatives in the SPECA countries to put the objective of the Strategy into practice: a sustained improvement in the national capacity and capabilities of the SPECA countries to formulate and implement innovation policies for sustainable development and a higher level and quality of regional cooperation in the implementation of innovations that target and support sustainable development.

Furthermore, the session is an opportunity for SPECA countries to comment on and contribute to the activities of UNECE and ESCAP in support of the Innovation Strategy and the Action Plan and implementation of the APIS action plan 2022-2026.

Delegates and participants

The participants of the WG on ITSD are nominated by Governments of the SPECA countries, representing senior public officials involved in the formulation and implementation of national innovation policies and policies and programmes related to digital connectivity and technology development. The participants of the subregional workshop preceding the WG session include policymakers, representatives of academia, and public and private sector institutions, involved in policies and initiatives in innovation and technology.
