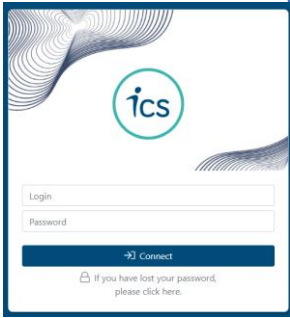

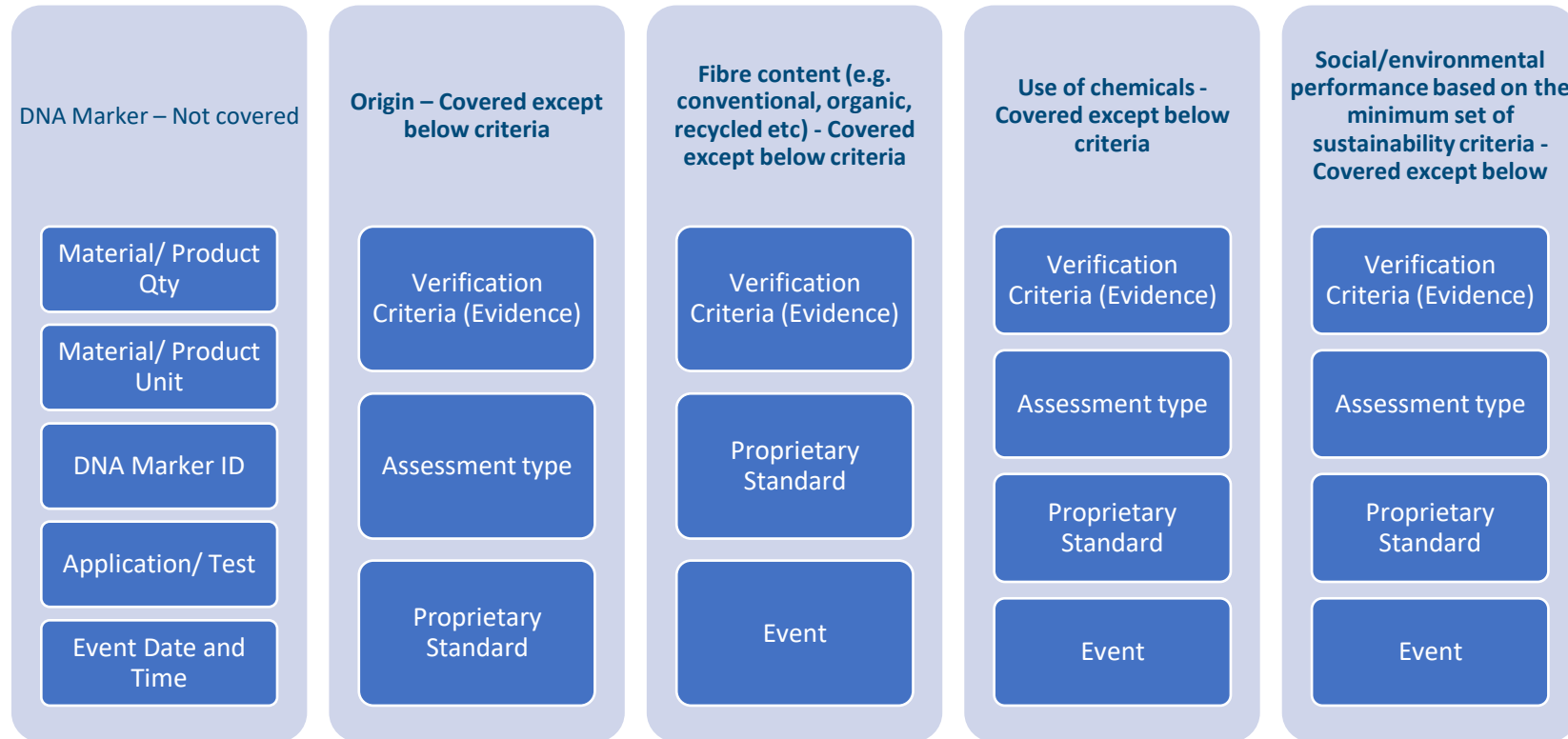

Current ICS/ITC Supply Chain Mapping project :

- *ICS works on the mapping on the production sites identified by their ICS Members using tools helping the identification from Tier 1 to Tier 4.*
- *The tools must help to consolidate data helping to ensure the tracking of the entities currently working for the ICS Members.*
- *ICS is not entitled to track all data referring to the products.*
- *ICS tools must help ICS members to consolidate data at their brand level with relevant and validated data regarding the production sites from Tier 1 to Tier 4.*

Based on this, would you be kind to confirm your statement and comments regarding the ICS participation to the below proposed UNECE Working Group :

- The UNECE Working Group is working on the definition of Traceability and Transparency standards.
- Those standards will include information from both Production Sites (Locations, Audits, Standards and Certifications) and Products (Components, Circularity...)
- ICS works with ITC for identifying and consolidating data about the Production Sites (Locations, Audits, Standards and Certifications)
- **Data coming from the products journey may help to validate the traceability links between production sites (Traceability events) and could be added to the ICS/ITC Factory Profile Tool**
- ICS won't work on Products data but proposes to develop in the short-mid term direct links (API) to populate ICS Members database with data from Production Sites (Locations, Audits, Standards and Certifications) and Traceability Events that could help to consolidate at brands / products levels the required information



Are there international standards on corporate sustainability due diligence?

[2011 United Nations Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights](#) state that companies should avoid infringing the human rights of others and should address adverse human rights impacts with which they are involved in their own operations and through their direct and indirect business relationships. The [OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises](#), related Guidance on Responsible Business Conduct and sectoral guidance specify and further develop this concept of due diligence. The recommendations of the [ILO Tripartite Declaration of Principles concerning Multinational Enterprises and Social Policy](#) also embed this concept. The OECD framework extended the application of due diligence to cover environmental harm.

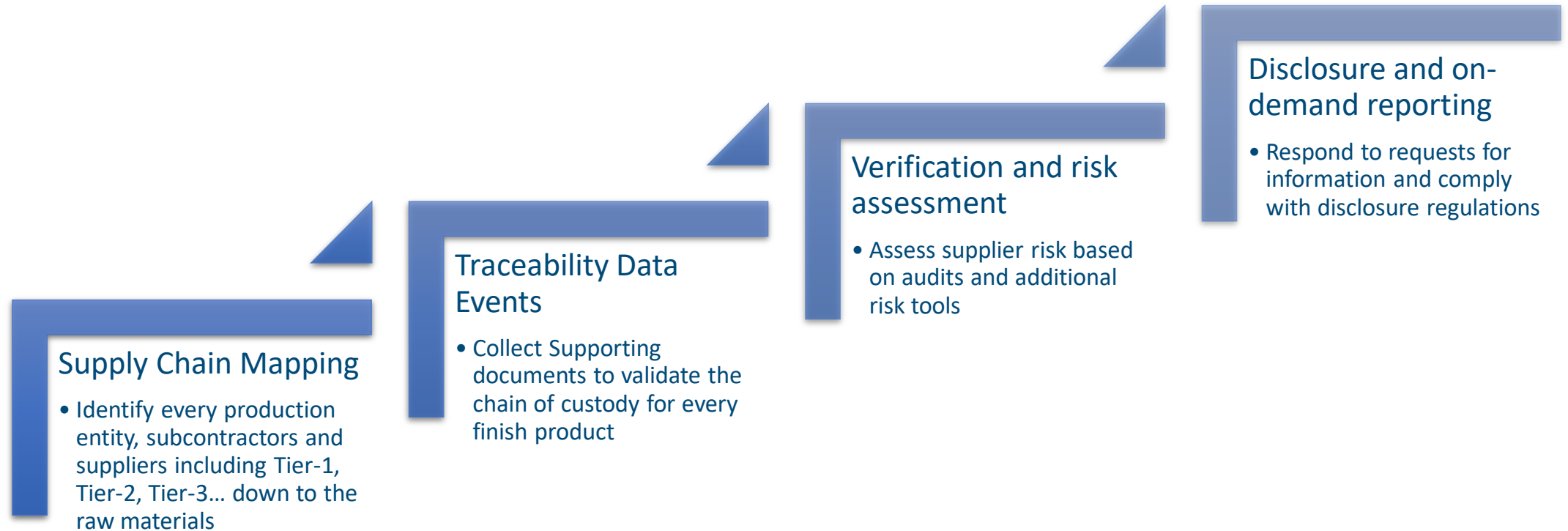
What are examples of mitigating measures?

The Commission has conducted a comprehensive mapping of existing EU-funded actions whose objectives and results are accompanying the implementation of the Directive. The mapping identified about 75 relevant ongoing Commission actions. An example of such action is the garment traceability project with UNECE and ITC. This project provides tools for companies that are immediately relevant for their due diligence obligations.

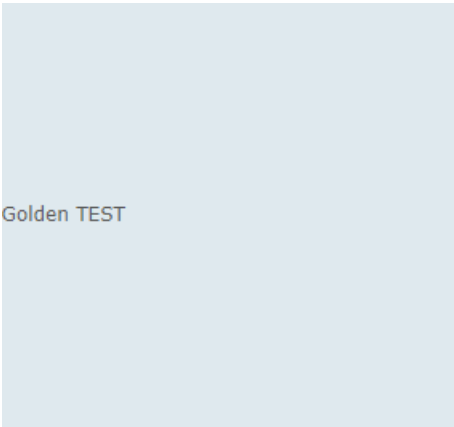
