


### **About the Steering Committee on Trade Capacity and Standards**



The **Steering Committee** is an intergovernmental body that **oversees** and **guides** the development of **international norms and standards, procedures and best practices** to:

- reduce the costs associated with export and import processes;
- increase the efficiency, predictability and transparency of trade regulations and procedures and the movement of goods and services.




### Achievements since previous session: SCTCS Regulatory and Procedural Barriers to Trade (RPBT) Studies



At its 8th session on 26-27 June 2023, the Steering Committee discussed and adopted related decisions on:

- RPBT Study for Kyrgyzstan, aimed at enhancing the country's agricultural export potential;
- RPBT Study for the Republic of Moldova, showcasing the progress regarding trade facilitation reforms and the areas for further improvement;
- Report on lessons learned from the RPBT studies undertaken since 2012 and a possible way forward;
- Document on integrating circular economy considerations into RPBT studies;
- Document on integrating digital economy considerations into RPBT studies.



## Achievements since previous session: Working Party 6 on Regulatory Cooperation and Standardization Policies



The 32nd session of WP.6 on 7-9 November 2022 and related meetings of its subsidiary bodies discussed the following deliverables:

- Revised Glossary of Market Surveillance Terms;
- Revision of Recommendation T on Standards and Regulations for Sustainable Development;
- Guidelines on developing GRS, four capacity-building workshops on GRS and a webinar on incorporating a gender perspective in standards for sustainability;
- The launch of the e-learning platform (> 400 registrations); and updates of the "Standards for SDGs" portal (>21,000 standards);
- Project on integrated risk management in Single Window systems.








# Achievements since the previous session: Working Party 7 on Agricultural Quality Standards



The 77th session of WP.7 on 14-16 November 2022 and related meetings of its subsidiary bodies discussed the following deliverables:

- Eight new or revised standards and three recommendations;
- Second edition of the UNECE Code of Good Practice on Reducing food loss;
- Econometric study in collaboration with OECD on assessing the impact of agricultural quality standards on the trade of fruit and vegetables.





#### Major activities planned for 2023 and beyond



#### **SCTCS RPBT Studies**

- Work on the ongoing and new RPBT Studies, including for Armenia, Azerbaijan and Turkmenistan;
- Technical assistance activities in Kyrgyzstan and the Republic of Moldova.



### WP 6 on Regulatory Cooperation and Standardization Policies

- Annual session, 23-24November 2023;
- Panel discussion on compliance for the changing dynamic of digital goods.



### WP 7 on Agricultural Quality Standards

- Annual session, **13-15 November 2023**;
- Adoption of new standards, revisions to several existing standard;
- Panel discussion on digitalization needs for agricultural trade;
- Rapporteur's meeting in Brest on 10-12 October 2023 organised by the Specialized Section on Standardization of Seed Potatoes (GE.6).
