Analysis of the current situation

- Registration of hazardous chemical substances and creation of a database
- Improvement of the monitoring system of chemical substances
- Assessment of risks of expected accidents and development of scenarios

Improving the reporting system for industrial accidents at the national and cross-border level

- Development of appropriate regulations for objects with increased risk
- Testing in accordance with internal and external emergency response plans
- Improving the reporting system for industrial accidents in a transboundary context, in accordance with the Convention on the Transboundary Investigation of Industrial Accidents

Ensuring the safety of chemically hazardous objects and substances

- Determining the measures to be taken in order to ensure safety at hazardous facilities
- Determining the measures to be taken in order to ensure safety at hazardous facilities
- Strengthening the capacities of the agencies responsible for ensuring the safety of chemically hazardous facilities

Response to chemical plant accidents

- At this stage, there is no national response plan for accidents at chemical plants

Cooperation with neighboring states

- Establishment of appropriate cooperation mechanisms with neighboring states

Raising public awareness

- Conducting an effective information campaign on the costs of implementing the Convention

Refinement of detection mechanisms

- Strengthening/improving detection methodology and system in accordance with international standards

Strengthening of environmental monitoring capabilities

- Expansion of the environmental pollution monitoring network
- Staff training in the mentioned field
