Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by Germany in connection with public participation on a draft amendment to the Climate Protection Act (ACCC/C/2023/203)

On 10 July 2023, the secretariat of the Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters (Aarhus Convention) received the above communication from Deutsche Umwelthilfe e.V. addressed to the Compliance Committee of the Convention. The communication concerns compliance by Germany with article 8 of the Convention in connection with public participation with respect to the draft amendment to the Climate Protection Act. The communication was submitted in accordance with the provisions of chapter VI of the annex to decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties.
