- One University Clinical Center
 - Nine Hospitals
 - Fifty five Primary Public Health Centers (with ER)
 - Public Health Institute of the Republic of Srpska
 - Six other Institutes



- ER in bigger cities have good quality equipment, but they would benefit from having more employes and more equipment.
- ER in smaller cities don't have enough equipment and employes.
- This all is affecting how fast ER will respond on emergency call



PROCEDURES

- Police → ER
- ER take care about injured and if it`s need transport to hospitals (or University Clinical Center)
- Hospitals (or University Clinical Center) after few days send information about injured to police

CONSEQUENCE	COSTS
DIED IN CAR ACCIDENTS	KM 3 001 (EUR 1 534)
LIFE TREATING INJURING	KM 5 584 (EUR 2 855)
MINOR INJURIES	KM 189 (EUR 97)



DATA FROM HEALTH INSURANCE IN REPUBLIC OF SRPSKA

- Average every year in car accident get hurt 3 500 person
- For one person cost is around 1 000 KM (511 EUR)
- For one year, for all injured costs are minimum 3,5 million KM (1,8 million EUR)
