Insert a new paragraph 1.1.1., to read:

"1.1.1. At the request of the manufacturer, this UN Regulation may also be applied to vehicles of Categories M₃, Class I."

Part II, insert a new paragraph 6.1.9., to read:

"6.1.9. *"Plastic glazing"* is a glazing material that contains as an essential ingredient, one or more organic polymeric substances of large molecular weight, is solid in its finished state and, at some stage in its manufacture or processing into finished articles, can be shaped by flow."

Part II, paragraph 6.2.7.1., amend to read:

"6.2.7.1. Parts made of metal or glass; Parts made of plastic glazing are not included in this exemption."
