Recommandations

- It is recommended to access and efficiently implement UN Vehicle Agreements on Type Approval (1958 Agreement), Certification (1998 Agreement) and on Periodic Technical Inspections (1997 Agreement) together with the related Resolutions R.E.3, R.E.5, R.E.6, R.e.7, M.R.1, M.R.2, M.R.3, M.R.4 and S.R.1.
- Minimum safety and ecology (maximum vehicle emission) requirements for new and second-hand vehicles should be adopted on national level
- Legislation on use of safety belts, child restraint systems and helmets should be revised based on the international best practice and latest scientific evidence, especially for exemption of use of safety belts and mandatory wearing of safety belts on rear seats.
- Resources and training for personnel which is checking mandatory use of tachographs for vehicle categories defined by the AETR Agreement should be provided. Gradual introduction of mandatory use of tachographs for all vehicle categories defined by the AETR (international and national transport.
