Re: Request for reconsideration of determination of inadmissibility of communication ACCC/C/2023/205 (Italy)

I write to inform you that, at their virtual meeting on 19 January 2024, the Chair and Vice-Chairs of the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee considered your request of 19 December 2023 that the Committee reconsider its determination at its eightieth meeting (Geneva, 19-22 September 2023) that the above communication was inadmissible.
