





Goal 17 is what New Taipei City believes to be the key to making things possible.


The city knows what role it plays in the global community, is ready to contribute more and will be more than happy for any opportunity for exchange and collaboration.

By preparing its first Voluntary Local Review (VLR), the municipality intends to assess and to present the progress made in the implementation of the SDGs, by understanding the current state of sustainability of the Municipality of Mafra.


An action plan for people, for prosperity and for the planet, aiming to strengthen universal peace with more freedom, the SDGs are definitely a commitment by all for all!


