



Stovepipe vs. process oriented organization





Generic Activity Model for Statistical Organisations (GAMSO)




- Activities in statistical organisations including HR, legal affairs
- Reference points for reorganization/structuring






Why GSBPM and GAMSO for ethis?


GeoGSBPM (2021) = GSBPM + Geospatial data

Feedback about ethics for GAMSO


- "...some possible aspects to include... data Stewardship, incl. ethics,
 Algorithm Charter"
- "On Corporate Support, it is helpful that it takes a cross-cutting perspective of systems and processes.... 'manage ethics' or something similar should be included as it is increasingly relevant to data sharing and linkage"
- "Some elements that emerged since the last preparation of version 1.2 need to have a place in the revised version, such as manage ethics and manage professional cooperations"

Option 1. Add texts around ethics in Strategy Leadership (define vision; govern and lead) and Corporate Support (manage business and performance; manage consumers)

Option 2. Create a new activity area "manage ethics" under Corporate Support
