After receiving his PhD in "Electrical Breakdown of Combustible Gases ..." in 1999, he took over the management of the working group "Explosion-Protected Drive Systems" from 2003-2016 and, from 2016-2020, headed PTB's "Explosion-Protection in Sensor Technology and Instrumentation" department and the conformity assessment sector for explosion protection.

Since 2021 he is responsible for the Division 9 "Legal and International Metrology. The activities include representing the interests of the PTB in various international organizations like OIML, COOMET, IEC/IECEX, European Commission and UNECE WP.6.
