

2. CONNECTION BETWEEN URBAN AREAS AND NATIONAL, AND REGIONAL LEVELS - Committee laid groundwork for afforestation/reforestation measures in countries and explored the links between local, national and regions, particularly through the adoption of the San Marino Regional Urban Forestry Action Plan (Nov. 2023).

United Nations Forum on Forests (UNFF18) - 8May 2023, side event on "Rooted in Forests – National and regional action for global impact" (organized with Uzbekistan, World Bank and FAO) - Spotlight on tools and opportunities for concrete regional and national actions and interventions

3. FOLLOW-UP TO ECE DECISIONS AND WORK:TRANSITION TO A CIRCULAR ECONOMY AND LEVERAGING DIGITALIZATION AND DIGITAL TRANSFORMATIONS FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT (aligned with the 70th session of ECE), the Committee worked and published material on:

- "Circularity Concepts in Wood Construction", "Circularity Concepts in the Pulp and Paper Industry" (forthcoming) "Sustainable and circular bioeconomy in forest-based industries" (forthcoming)
- UNECE/FAO Policy Dialogue in Türkiye Spotlight on the future of the forestry and wood-based industries sector in Türkiye in the transition to a sustainable bioeconomy (21-23 Sept. 2023)
- Expansion of INForest and prepared automation of its data collection processes
- Creation of digital Forest Knowledge Platform and trained on Forest Information Systems



Intersectoral activities

Joint Working Party and Teams of Specialists and informal groups (Informal Network of Experts on Urban Nature) are at the forefront of building interfaces between the science and policy community.

- Nexus work:
 - Energy-forest nexus and cross-divisional cooperation
 - Water-forest nexus and cooperation with the Water Convention, particularly in dry cities
