Milestones in the past years:



- **2015:** UN/LOCODE Focal Point Network
- **2017:** UN/LOCODE Advisory Group
- **2019:** UN/LOCODE Maintenance Team
- **2020 :** Fourth revision of Rec. 16



- New maintenance procedure:
 - Collaboration among the secretariat, national Focal Points and experts.
 - Implementation of the revised Rec. 16
- Maintenance issues
 - Raised by the Maintenance Team on an ongoing basis
 - Submitted to the Advisory Group for further guidance
- Decision 20-9: set up a task force to study the issues related to the Special Economic Zone (SEZ)
- Necessity to clarify and address the maintenance issues by a dedicated platform

- Unlike the digital world: 1 or 0
- Cases in the grey areas
- Need maintenance policies for
 - Consistent interpretation of Rec. 16
 - Standardizing the maintenance
 - Balanced point: standard & exceptions

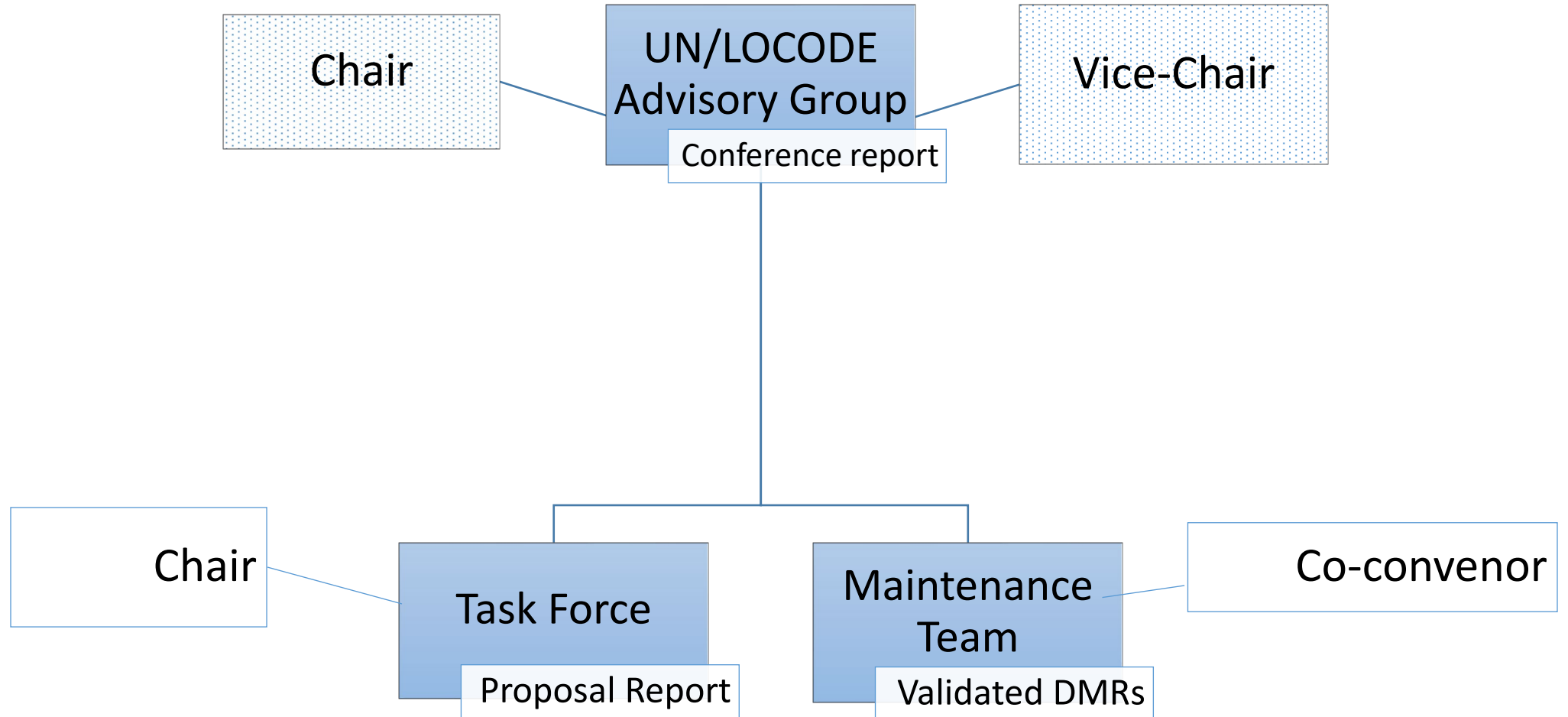
