A brief history...



- A growing user need for
 - More detailed information on certain sectors of the economy (thematic) or
 - Information including activities and assets that are not typically within the national accounts' boundaries (extended)
- The CES Bureau decided to carry out an in-depth review of satellite accounting in 2019 to identify challenges and best practices

A brief history...



- Main recommendations from the in-depth review:
 - A general Guide to Satellite Accounting (in addition to rich guidance developed independently)
→ OECD + 2025 SNA
 - Online inventory of published satellite accounts (to enhance learning from others)
→ UNECE in coordination with other IOs
- Results:
 - Satellite accounts wiki (2020), interactive website (2024):

 - About 950 accounts from almost one hundred countries, covering nearly 40 different topics + international guidance
