Points of focus 1/2

Improve the availability of **regional EFs**

- To better represent variations in legislative coverage

Better representation of **temperature** in methodologies

- To reflect Nordic to Mediterranean coverage

Better coverage of methodologies for “**future**” **sources**

- H_2 combustion. NH_3 as fuel etc.

Better availability of datasets from **satellite measurement**

- NO_x from soils, fires etc.
