INS Romania's Experience with CAPI Data Collection for Household Statistical Surveys using Survey Solutions Platform

Abstract

In today's digital age, precise and efficient statistical data collection is essential for providing reliable and valuable information to governments, economies, and society as a whole. In this context, the National Institute of Statistics of Romania (INS Romania) has developed significant expertise in the use of CAPI technology for data collection through the Survey Solutions platform, developed by the World Bank. This presentation aims to provide an in-depth perspective on how INS Romania has implemented and benefited from CAPI using the Survey Solutions platform. We will explore the advantages and challenges encountered in this transition to digital data collection in household statistical surveys, highlighting how this process has increased the efficiency, quality, and timeliness of the collected data. Additionally, we will discuss the lessons learned by INS Romania in this process, including training and supervision strategies and data processing. INS Romania's experience can provide a solid foundation for other organizations interested in implementing CAPI technology in their statistical data collection efforts.
