## World Water Forum:

- The **largest international** forum in the water sector involving various stakeholders
- The Forum is held **every three years** and has been taking place since 1997
- The World Water Forum is **not just a conference**: it includes a three-year preparation phase (preparatory phase), a one-week event (event phase), and a presentation of the results (synthesis phase) with ongoing support for **collective action**

## The main missions of the World Water Forum 2024 are to:

- provide a **platform for all stakeholders** in the water sector to **engage, exchange, learn together, and catalyze concrete ideas** for improved water resources management and development
- encourage **innovative thinking** to overcome contemporary and critical water resource management issues
- mobilize **action by policy and decision-makers on commitments** for improved water resources management and development
