



Historical development of the LOS



- ➤ Previous version was adopted December 2009
- ➤ Amendments 10 times: 2010 (twice), 2011, 2013 (twice), 2015 (twice), 2016 (twice), 2017
- ➤ Substantial changes in 2015 and 2016
- ➤ AGA 2012 recommendations substantial part of amendments
- From 30 August, 2023 the new Law on "Official Statistics of Georgia"

GA 2019 recommendations related LOS



- Professional independence
- > Selection and appointment of Executive Director and his status
- > Role and mandate of Board
- > Access to data held by private companies
- > Data confidentiality (to exclude the current reference in Article 28.2)
- > Access to microdata for research purposes







Drafting processes of the new Law



- Task force was set up
- > Support from the STEP project
- > Involvement of international expert
- > Consultations with other producers and data providers
- Consultations with stakeholders
- Final consultations with government ministries and agencies


Content of new LOS




- ☐ Based on GLOS structure and main principles
- Based on GA recommendations

Compared with the current law following issues are more clearly described:

- > Definition of "Official statistics" and its difference from administrative data
- > Definition of producers of official statistics
- > Professional independence of statistical bodies
- > Geostat's role and significance in the coordination of the NSS
- > Mandate and functions of the management board and advisory council
- > Access to administrative and other data sources
- Access to microdata for research purposes
- Data quality management








Difference from the previous LOS (1) General changes




- > Renewed definition of terms
- > Better presentation of fundamental principles of official statistics
- > The rule for the definition of other producers
- > Role of GEOSTAT in coordinating the NSS










Difference from the previous LOS (2) Selection and appointment of the executive director



- > Selected on the basis of open competition
- > Elected by an independent competition commission
- > Appointed by the prime minister with the consent of the Parliament of Georgia



Upon appointment as the director, becomes a member of the Geostat Board and the Advisory
 Council - in the capacity of chairman of both boards (Article 10)



Responsibilities of the Executive Director

To approve/introduce statistical standards, classifications and methodologies to be used in statistical activities

Difference from the previous LOS (3) Coordination



- ➤ More precise definition for criteria and status of other producing bodies of official statistics (Article 6)
- Their functions, obligations and role has been defined (Article 12)
- ➤ Provision of statistical data and access to the micro data in the system has been defined (Article 12)







- ➤ Changes in managing board (Article 13)
 - Number of members increased by 1 person (from 8 to 9)
 - Selection and appointment procedures were changed
 - Their functions have been changed and reduced (Article 15)

Difference from the previous LOS (4) Data confidentiality



- > Confidentiality criteria has been updated
- > Access to confidential data and relevant obligations
- > Access to microdata for research purposes





➤ Use of individual data for non-statistical purposes is excluded (criminal investigation, surveillance, conducting court proceedings, making administrative decisions, etc.)

Difference from the previous LOS (5) Cooperation with respondents



The process of submitting the request for the provision of appropriate information to the respondent in electronic form

has been simplified



The submission of a written request to an addressee shall be confirmed with a relevant document, while receipt of an electronic letter by respondent shall be confirmed with a corresponding reply letter.



and An electronic notification sent to the e-mail address of the legal entities is considered officially delivered to this person.

Difference from the previous LOS (6) Censuses



Types of censuses has been defined: (Article 28, 30)

- > Population census
- > Agricultural census
- **Economic Census**



The rules, forms and periodicity for the censuses has been defined (Article 31)

Obligations and responsibilities of respondents has been defined (article 29, 31))
