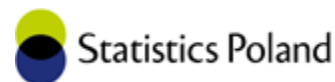

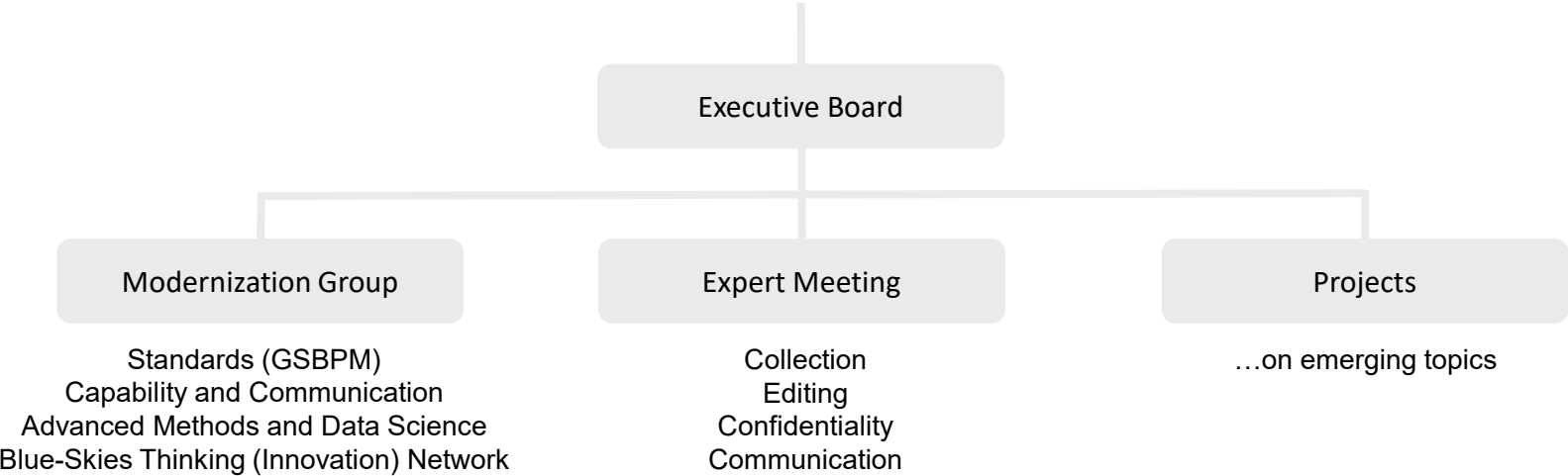

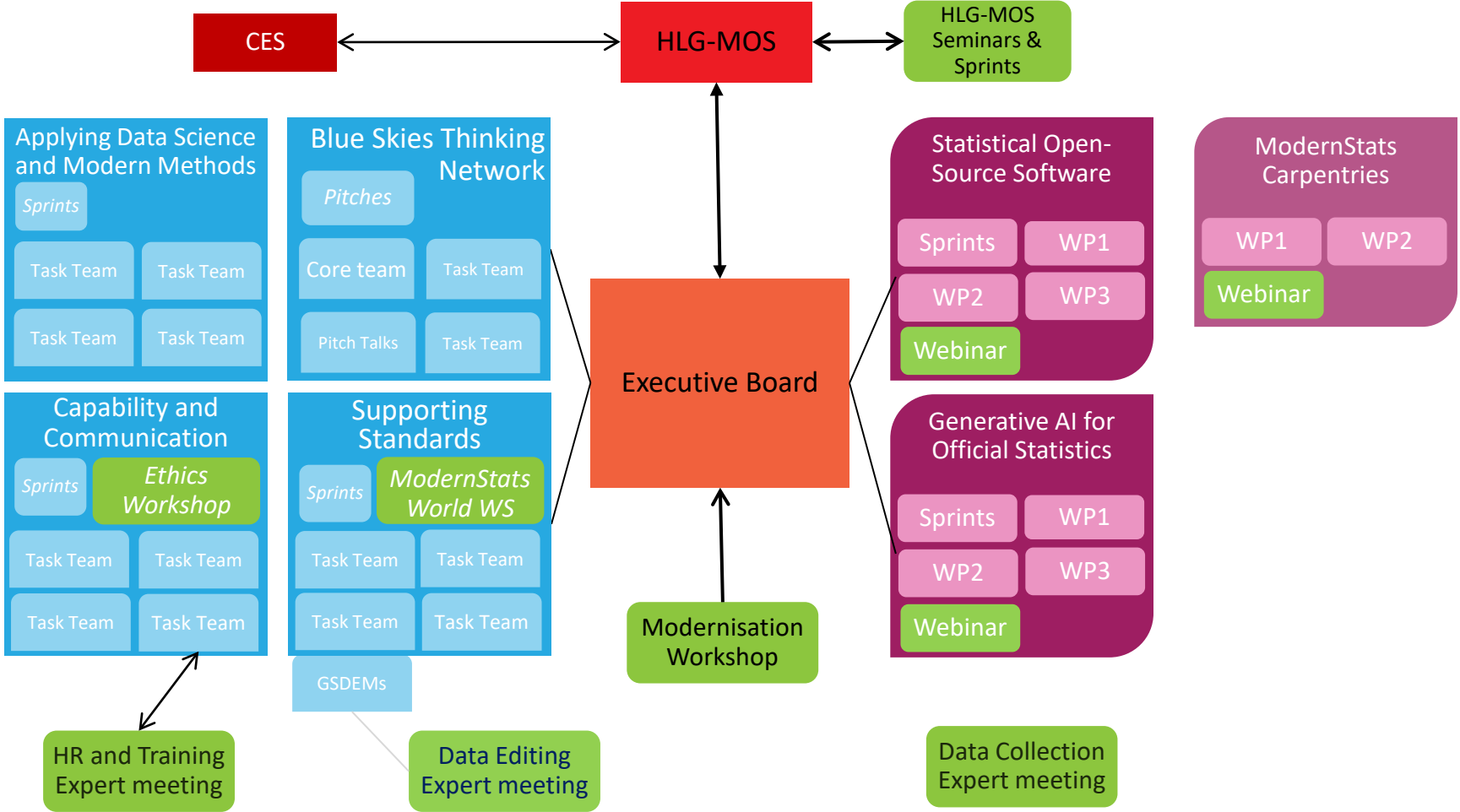
HLG MOS - General structure

The group is focused on addressing issues such as:

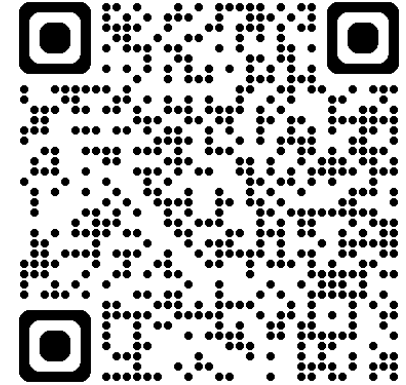
- ✓ Ethics and data ethics in statistics, including ethics workshop and preparation of a reference book on ethics,

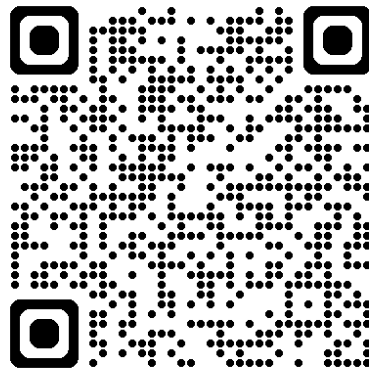

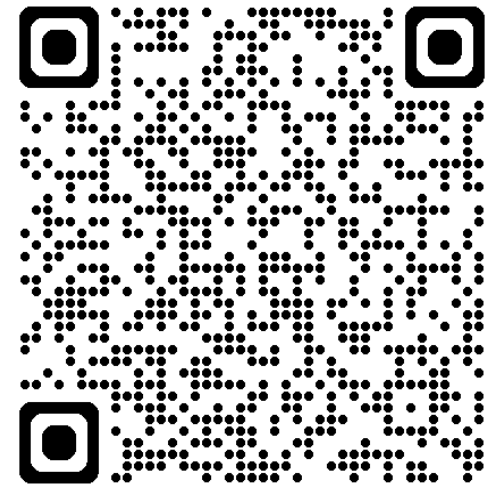
