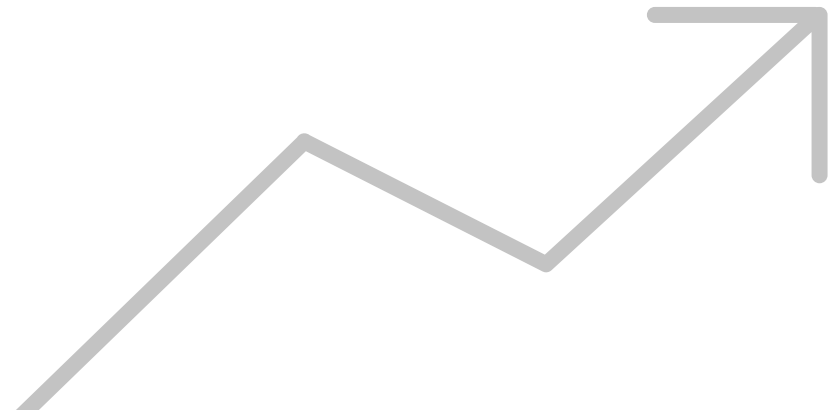

Background

- » UNECE Steering Group on Measuring Quality of Employment (chair: CAN, GER)
 - » established in 2015 by CES Bureau, members:
Australia, Austria, Azerbaijan, Canada, Finland, Germany, Israel, Italy, Kazakhstan, Norway, Poland, Singapore, Sweden, Switzerland, United States, Eurofound, Eurostat, ILO, OECD, Upjohn Institute, Women in Informal Employment: Globalizing and Organizing (WIEGO).
 - » coordinating and guiding work in the area of QoE
 - » Handbook on Measuring QoE: implementation, update and further development
 - » mandated by ‚Terms of Reference‘



Background

- » Current ‚Terms of Reference‘ SG Measuring QoE 2023-2028
 - » Promoting and following up on the implementation of the Handbook QoE
 - » Organising biennial Expert Group meetings
 - » Promoting the Handbook on Forms of Employment
 - » Keeping the statistical framework and the list of indicators up-to-date
 - » Identifying emerging issues

Background

- » Work of the Steering Group in the last decade
 - » updating the list of indicators: addendum to the Handbook available for download
 - » several conceptual issues (impact of ICLS resolutions), developing new indicators
 - » reviews the Handbook and identifies areas where updates should be considered
- » Steering Group's recommendation
 - » launch an update of the Handbook on Quality of Employment
 - » incorporate the developments since 2015
 - » » maintain the relevance and practical usability of the Handbook !

Follow-up of the Handbook QoE



Impact of ICLS Resolutions

- » 19th Resolution on statistics of work, employment and labour underutilization
 - » other forms of work than employment
 - » assessment of indicators, give guidance for indicators where appropriate
 - » not to change the scope, focus remains on employment

- » 20th Resolution concerning statistics on work relationships
 - » new Classification of Status in Employment: ICSE-18
 - » touches on definition or breakdowns of some QoE indicators
 - » changes should be included in the QoE Handbook

- » 21th Resolution concerning statistics on the informal economy
 - » experimental indicator on informal employment
 - » assessment of possible impact on the framework

Forms of Employment

- » constant changes in labour markets: new forms of employment
- » Handbook on Forms of Employment (2022) as a conceptual framework for measuring forms of employment
- » Subgroup on forms of employment under the Steering Group of QoE
- » update the Handbook on Measuring QoE
 - » analyzing the impact of the work on forms of employment
 - » include relevant common aspects, at least on the indicators

Further topics

» QoE-Indicators

- » checking the list of indicators
- » update existing indicators
- » develop new indicators

» System of National Accounts 2025

- » update of the SNA planned for 2025
- » guidance on employment and labour accounts
- » include reference to the updated SNA content in the QoE Handbook

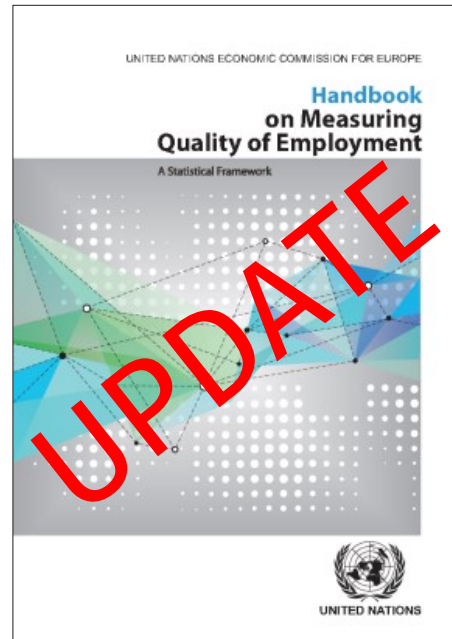
