2012 – ongoing; 16 countries








Tasks of an EPR expert

Preparing the review mission

- Terms of Reference and layout of the chapter provided by the UNECE secretariat
- Gathering information and data
 - Preparing a questionnaire
 - Preparing a list of interviews
 - Communicating, if possible, with the focal point(s) to ensure a basic agenda for the review mission

Participating to the review mission

- Meeting with governmental representatives at national and local levels, NGOs, international organizations and donors, academia and the private sector (plenary and individual meetings)
- Direct technical advice

Drafting the chapter

- Terms of Reference and layout to be followed
- Addressing SDGs
- Assessing the implementation of the recommendations of the previous EPR, if needed
- Primary data from national statistics office, otherwise international databases
