




Pre-crisis Vulnerability

Managing services during Crisis

How to stem the rate of decline?

Five pernicious problems:

- 1. Inadequately governed water resources
- 2. Aggressive competition from alternative providers
- 3. Paralysis of high-tech facilities
- 4. Escalating energy costs
- 5. The cashflow crunch



HOW TO ASSESS RESPONSIVENESS OF WASH SERVICE PROVIDERS

Pre-crisis Information:

• Baseline / key indicators and statistics

Crisis specific information:

• Affected areas and populations, impact / sectoral impact, etc...

Enables a more in-depth analysis:

 Indicators, patterns/trends of the crisis as well as underlying factors (pre-crisis vulnerabilities)

First step in shifting from reactive to proactive (data and information)



TOWARDS EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE PLAN

Emergency Planning Process

- Partnerships
- Policies, Procedures, Actions and Documentation
- Scenario Planning
- Emergency Response Plan Policies
- Coordination Mechanism(s) and Procedures
- System Specific Information Asset Inventory

- Alternative Water Sources
- Public Notification
- Pre-positioning of equipment, spare parts and consumables as well as dispatch stations
- Trainings, exercises and drills

Emergency Action Procedures

• Detailed procedures in the event of an emergency based on specific scenarios
