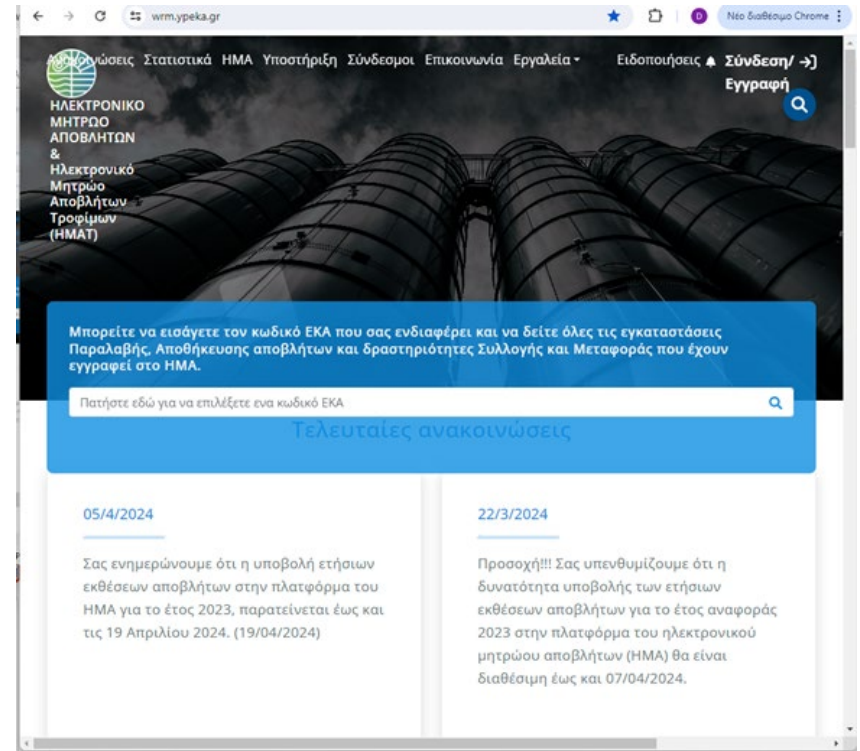

HELLENIC ELECTRONIC REGISTER ON WASTE

- An electronic service provided by the Hellenic Ministry of Environment and Energy
- Electronic registration of entities (Businesses and Organizations) that have the obligation to submit Waste Reports
- Registration of the activities of the obliged entities (Facilities and waste transfer activities)
- For each activity declaration of the EWC codes managed and submission of the related permits
- Utility for the submission of the Annual Waste Reports of the obliged entities
- Additional utility for the reporting of food waste



LEGISLATION

- Commission Directive (EU) 2015/1127 of 10 July 2015 amending Annex II to Directive 2008/98/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on waste and repealing certain Directives.
- Directive 2008/98/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19 November 2008 on waste and repealing certain Directives.
- Law 4042/2012 - OG 24/A/13-2-2012 introducing a framework for the generation and management of waste, among other provisions.
- JMD 43942/4026/2016 - OG 2992/B/19-9-2016 for the establishment of an electronic register on waste

STAKEHOLDERS

- Businesses/activities, waste generators, that are subject to environmental licensing
- Licensed waste warehouses and waste reception units for the implementation of disposal and recovery operations
- Licensed waste collectors-transporters
- Municipalities
- Solid waste management bodies

ACCESS TO THE ELECTRONIC REGISTER ON WASTE

- User management utility
- Helpdesk available for users' support
- Facilities and transfer activities should register the following:
 - VAT data
 - Address
 - Communication details
 - NACE codes
 - EWC codes
 - Deposit/Treatment codes
 - Permits related to the above

WASTE REPORT

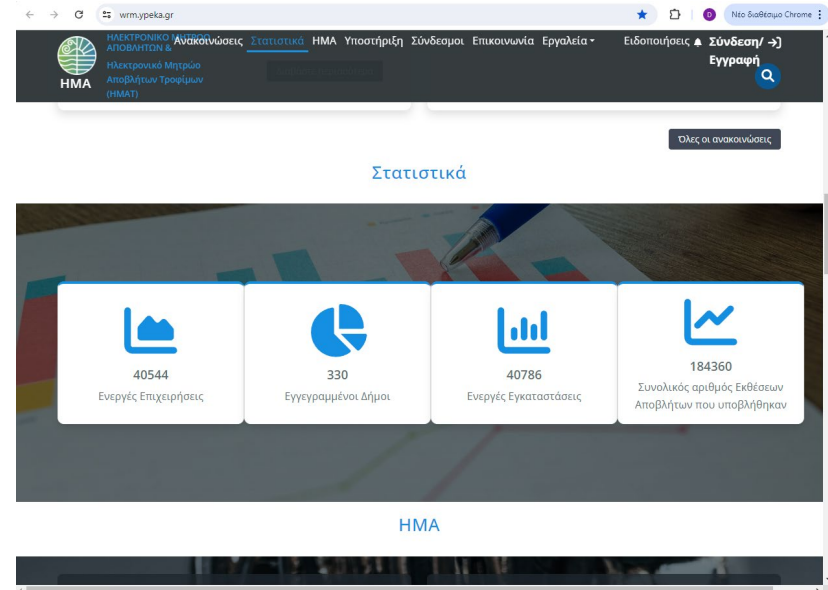
- The Waste Report is an annual report
- It is submitted electronically using the Waste Register of the Ministry of Environment and Energy
- The Waste Report is submitted for each Facility and waste collection-transfer activity of the obliged companies
- The submission of the report is required before the deadline set by legislation
- After the expiry of the deadline, the system does not accept further modification of the Waste Report, which is submitted automatically on the final day.
- The obligees can still modify the Waste Report for a short time frame after the expiry of the deadline by paying a small fee.

WASTE REPORT

- Waste generators facilities report quantities of generated waste per EWC code and Deposit/ Treatment code
- For Transfer /Storage operations they define partners that undertake these operations
- For each waste that was transferred to external facilities they report quantities of generated waste per EWC code and Deposit/ Treatment code together with the company that undertook the transfer activity and the destination facility
- Likewise, companies that undertake waste transfers report the quantities of transferred waste per EWC code, the waste generator facility and the destination facility.
- Storage and waste management facilities report received quantities per EWC code and Deposit/treatment code, the waste generator facility and transfer activity.
- Where Transfer/Storage operations are involved waste quantities must be reported by all partners that are participating in the process this way allowing cross-checking of waste reported.

SYSTEM USE

- 40.544 active enterprises
- 330 Registered Municipalities
- 40.786 active facilities
- 185.360 submitted Waste Reports



INITIAL PHASE OF THE PROJECT

- Establishment of a solid institutional framework for waste reporting.
- Communication campaign for the new waste reporting using the electronic register.
- Consistent Helpdesk -12 hours operation. Very big number of calls for assistance by the obliges.
- Dedicated team to examine submissions and provide guidance for data entry and software applications improvements.

AVAILABLE REPORTS

- Obligees are given the possibility to print the Waste Report, so that it can also be presented in paper form, should that be needed.
- Statistics for local authorities per EWC code.
- Search for facilities and waste management companies based on the EWC code or codes they handle.
- Utility for authenticity verification of Waste Register certificates.
- Detailed reports for the data entered to the system are available for the Waste Register operators.
- The Waste Register is the main source of the press releases on solid waste statistics of the Hellenic Statistical Authority and provides valuable data for the calculation of Waste Indicators.

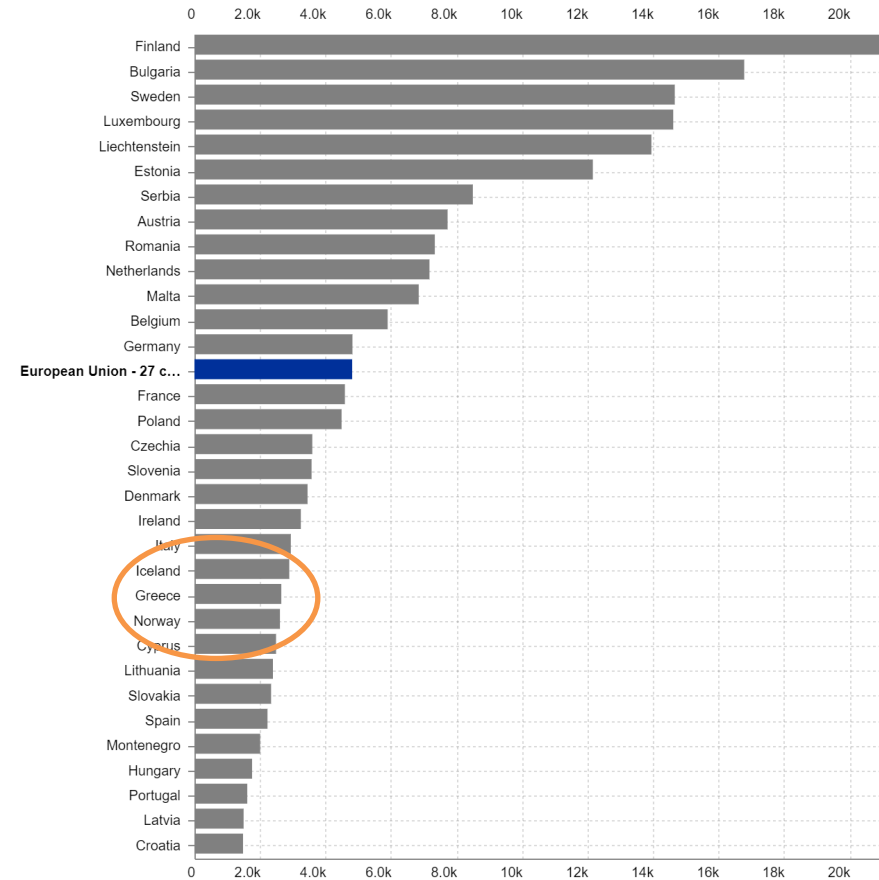
WASTE INDICATORS

Waste generation per capita

Time frequency: Annual
Unit of measure: Kilograms per capita

Hazard class: Hazardous and non-hazardous - Total

Statistical classification of economic activities in the European Community (NACE Rev. 2): All NACE activities plus households
Waste categories: Total waste
