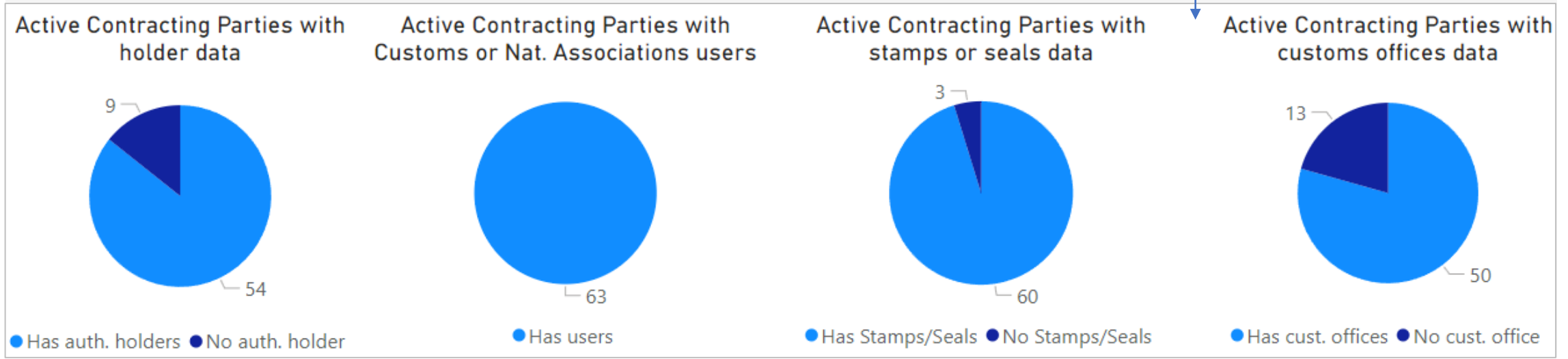
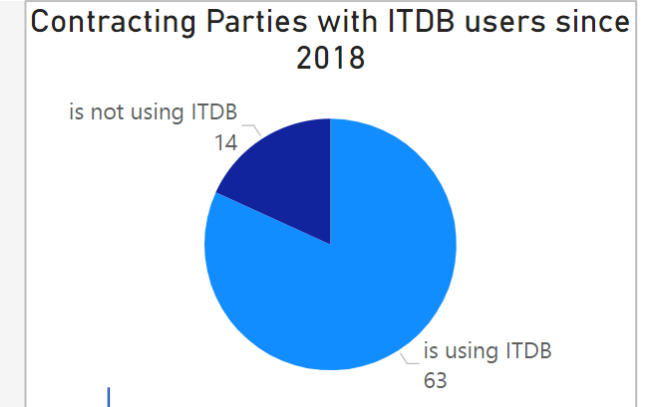

General ITDB data status



- 1,181 web application users *(since 2018)* +18
 - 30,263 authorized holders +178
 - 295 stamps and seals records +11
 - 2,754 TIR customs offices -237

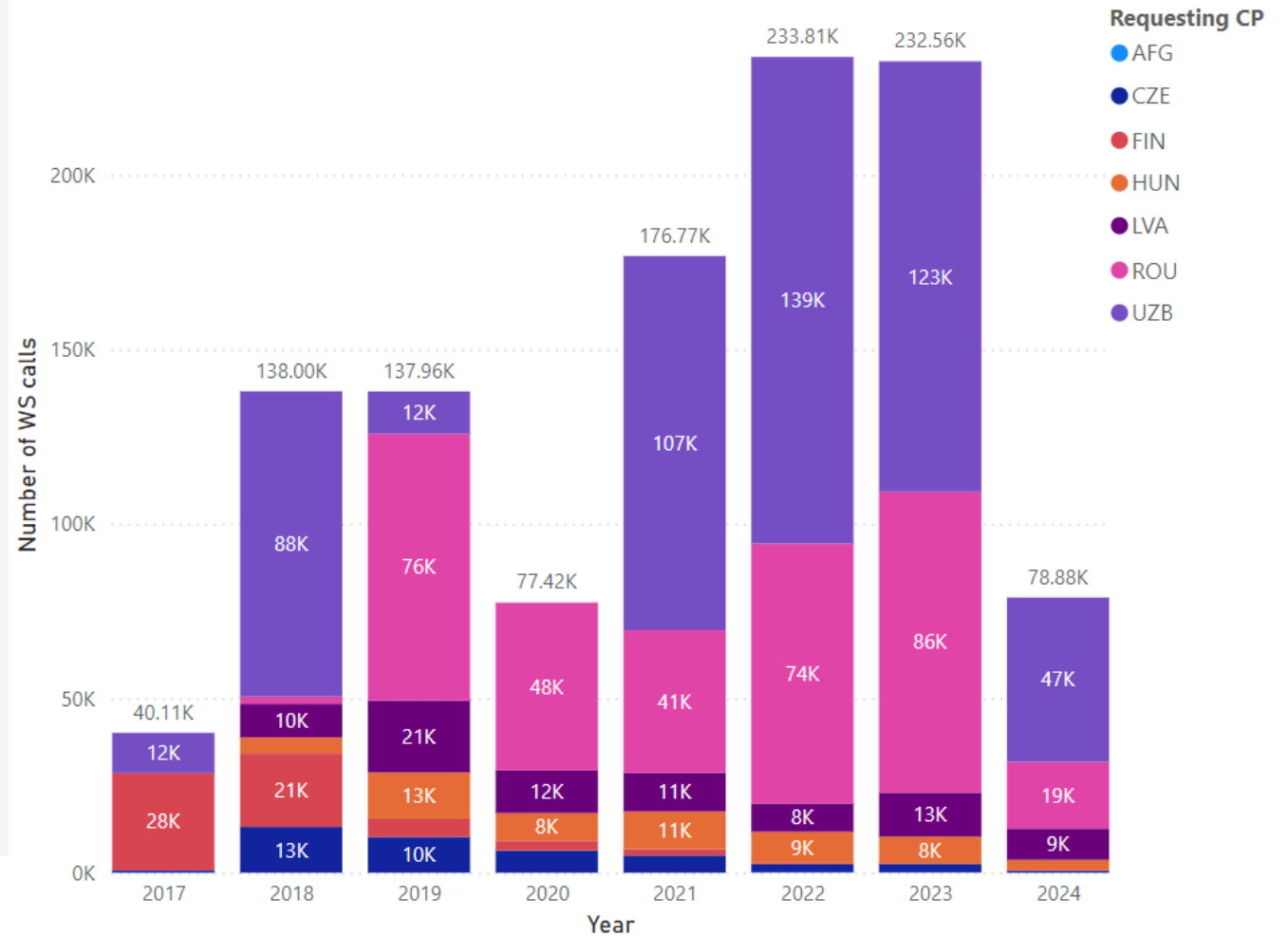


ITDB web service usage



- Approximately 138,000 WS calls in 2018 & 2019
 - 77,700 WS calls in 2020
 - 176,710 WS calls in 2021
 - 233,810 WS calls in 2022
 - 232,560 WS calls in 2023
 - 78,880 WS calls for far in 2024
- *Current trend below 2023*

Recent achievements:

- eTIR National Application:
 - API implementation completion
 - Language support extension (Kazak, Persian, Tajik)
- Study of ITDB web service extension request made by Uzbekistan
- Identification of a need to change eTIR specifications and ITDB data model to indicate the capacity for a customs office to support eTIR procedure.

Planned activities for the coming quarter:

- eTIR National Application:
 - Work on next potential deployments (Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Kazakhstan)
 - Study of new feature requests
 - Language support extension: Kyrgyz
- Work on ITDB web service extension
