SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY

Gabrielle White is a Manager of Trade Policy, currently working for Transport Canada where she leads strategic input on transportation related elements of Canada's Free Trade Agreements. In this role she leads in areas related to Technical Barriers to Trade and Good Regulatory Practices. She has held the position of Vice-Chair of UNECE Working Party 6 since 2021.

In her previous role as Senior Policy Advisor with the Department of Natural Resources, she managed the department's Standards Secretariat and focused on increasing collaboration between the department's technical experts.

Prior to this, Gabrielle spent eight years with the Standards Council of Canada (SCC) where her work focused on standards and conformance and oversaw input on the standardization components of Canada's trade agreements and regulatory cooperation. In addition to her work in trade policy, Gabrielle was responsible for spearheading SCC's gender and standardization strategy and continues to champion work on gender equality.

She holds a master's degree in Sociology from Queen's University.
