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Proposal for amending the annexes I and II of the European Agreement on Important International Combined Transport Lines and Related Installations

I. Explanation

Bulgaria, as Contracting Party to the European Agreement on Important International Combined Transport Lines and Related Installations (AGTC), wishes to propose amendments to annexes I and II of the AGTC as provided in point II below. C–E 855 (Calafat –) Vidin – Sofija – Kulata (– Promachon)


C–E 720 (Kriva Palanka–) Gyueshevo – Radomir– Sofija –Plovdiv– Zimintza-Karnobat-Burgas
