

ADR Driver Training Certificate – Ireland

Explanatory notes from Ireland in accordance with ADR 8.2.2.8.6

The Health and Safety Authority (HSA) is the competent authority in Ireland for dangerous goods classes 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 9. In relation to these classes of dangerous goods, the HSA has appointed the Chartered Institute of Logistics Ireland (CILT) as the competent authority to:

- approve driver basic and tanker specialisation training courses;
- examine persons who have completed such training; and
- issue driver training certificates.

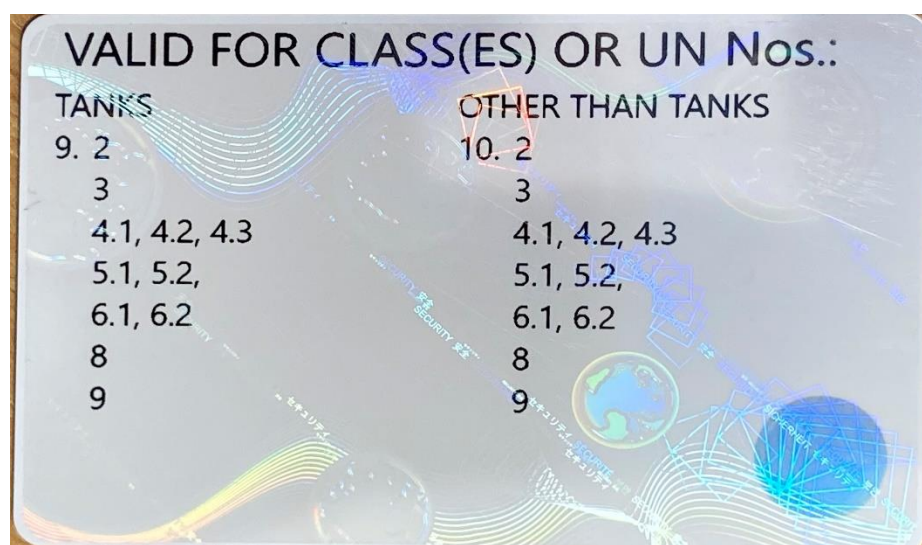
A sample of the new ADR driver training certificate issued by CILT from 9 October 2023 is shown below.

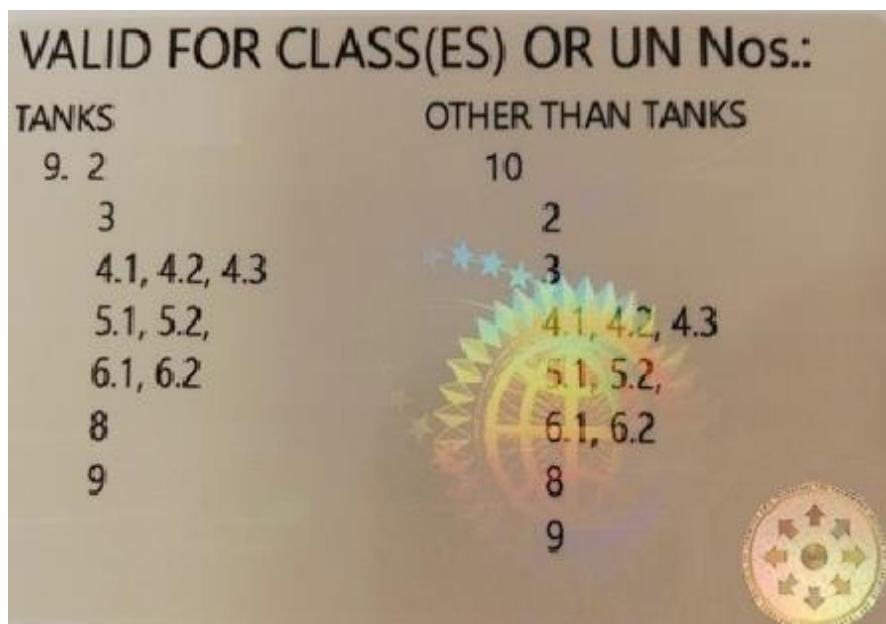
A sample certificate issued by CILT from 1 November 2019 to 8 October 2023 is shown below. This certificate is valid until 31 October 2024.

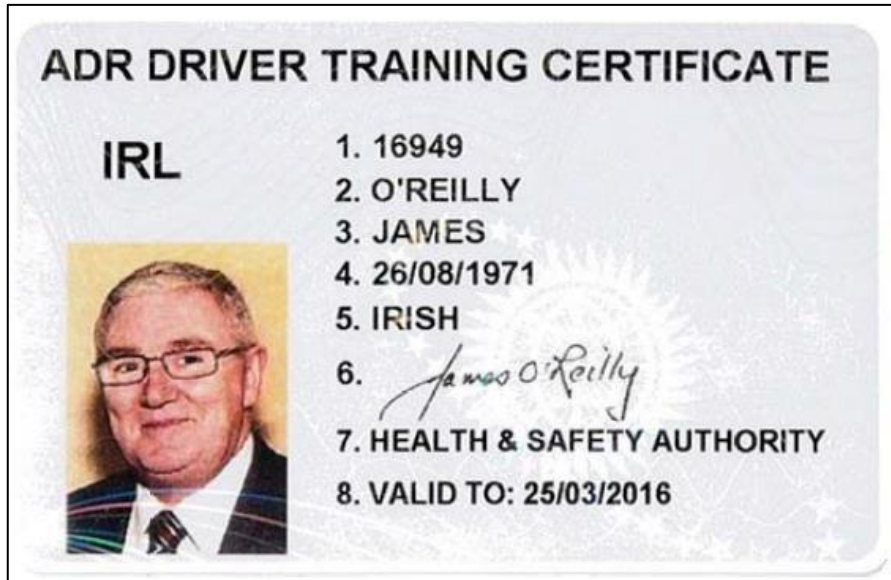
